## A Prayer for the Anglican Orthodox Church

### AUTHORIZATION:

At the request of the number of members of the Church for a prayer to be used both privately and in the public worship of the Church, Bishop Dees has authorized the following prayer for such use, pursuant to authority granted him by Canon 28 of the Church's Constitution and Canons. It is recommended that in Morning Prayer it be used after the sermon among the miscellaneous prayers and that in the Holy Communion Service it be used among the various prayers immediately before The Prayer for the Whole State of Christ's Church. It is also recommended that everyone use it extensively in their private devotions. We remember the Scripture: "Except the Lord build the house they labour in vain that build it." And the words of Alfred Lord Tennyson, **"More things are wrought by prayer than this world dreams of."**

### A Prayer for the Anglican Orthodox Church

O Lord our heavenly Father, look down from heaven, we pray on thy holy church, and especially on our Anglican Orthodox Church.

Fill it with thy Holy Spirit of peace, power, wisdom, and goodness, and make it strong in the will to do thy will. Keep it from all danger, evil and error, and defend it from all of its enemies. Bring into its fold thy countless children who are wandering today as sheep without a Shepherd, that they may be fed with the Living Bread and nourished with the Water of Life.

Move the hearts of thy people to give to it generously of their bounty as Thou had given to them that they may flourish for thy
