For the Christmas AOC Sunday Report¹ this ran as Rev Geordie's sermon. He wrote me a follow-up to let me know it was something he found, he has no idea who wrote it. But, to me it sounds like something he would write. You decide. I ran it again to make sure you would get a chance to read it. It is that good.

He Walked Out Of Heaven

He came from splendor to be born in poverty. He left the presence of angels for the company of me. He laid down a scepter in heaven to be laid in a manger and exchanged the worship of Arch-angels for the praise of lowly shepherds.

He walked into the world with all the power of Almighty God at his bidding but He was carried out a mutilated body lowered from a cross.

He rebuked the pious but He comforted the sinner. He refused earthly Kingship although He was still a King. He loved His mother yet gave her away at the Cross. He healed the broken-hearted yet He himself died with a broken heart.

He loved the fellowship of friends yet was cast out by His kinsmen. He rebuked both sage and seer and then blessed the little children. He held an executive meeting on the Mount of Transfiguration then wept alone in the Garden of Gethsemane.

He could walk on water, but could not walk away from the tears in the eyes of the Widow from Nain. He could command the stars in their orbits but he refused to change the circumstances of His own execution. His mission was a commitment to free all men yet He was imprisoned on the testimony of one man.

He delivered many from pain but He was delivered to suffer agonizing pain. He dried the eyes of multitudes but no one dried His eyes in Gethsemane. He carried the burdens of the world but only one was brought forth to help Him bear His Cross to Calvary.

His execution was thought to be insignificant, but became the controversy of the ages. His life was extinguished in a brief second of time but then ignited to lighten the world. His short span of thirty-three years on Earth should have passed unnoted were it possible but no one life has ever had such impact on the minds of men.

His three and one-half years in the public's eye was brief indeed but His achievements are the greatest ever recorded.

He shared all that he had and then on the Cross. He shared paradise with a thief. He gave the World light only to be driven into the cavern of Death. He gave mankind guidance only to be guided to Golgotha. He pointed men to the Tree of Life and they nailed Him to a tree on a hill called The Skull. He laid down a scepter in heaven to be laid in a borrowed tomb.

He walked out of heaven pure perfect and beautiful. He returned beaten mutilated and nail scarred. He fulfilled all that was written of Him and yet man did not believe Him. His coming changed the course of nations His return will be to judge the nations. His title was simple as stated on the Cross "Jesus of Nazareth • King of the Jews"; but to those who have ever known Him, He is Jesus Christ the Son of the living God.

Propers

Each Sunday there are Propers: special prayers and readings from the Bible. There is a Collect for the Day; that is a single thought prayer, most written either before the re-founding of the Church of England in the 1540s or written by Bishop Thomas Cranmer, the first Archbishop of Canterbury after the re-founding.

The Collect for the Day is to be read on Sunday and during Morning and Evening Prayer until the next Sunday. The Epistle is normally a reading from one of the various Epistles, or letters, in the New Testament. The Gospel is a reading from one of the Holy Gospels, Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. The Collect is said by the minister as a prayer, the Epistle can be read by either a designated reader (as we do in our church) or by one of the ministers and the Holy Gospel, which during the service in our church is read by an ordained minister.

The propers are the same each year, except if a Red Letter Feast, that is one with propers in the prayerbook, falls on a Sunday, then those propers are to be read instead, except in a White Season, where it is put off. Red Letter Feasts, so called because in the Altar Prayerbooks the titles are in red, are special days. Most of the Red Letter Feasts are dedicated to early saints instrumental in the development of the church, others to special events. Some days are particularly special and the Collect for that day is to be used for an octave (eight days) or an entire season, like Advent or Lent.

The propers for today are found on Page 102-103, with the Collect first:

The Holy Innocents. [December 28.]

The Collect.

O ALMIGHTY God, who out of the mouths of babes and sucklings hast ordained strength, and madest infants to glorify thee by their deaths; Mortify and kill all vices in us, and so strengthen us by thy grace, that by the innocency of our lives, and constancy of our faith even unto death, we may glorify thy holy Name; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

The First Sunday after Christmas Day.

The Collect.

A LMIGHTY God, who hast given us thy only-begotten Son to take our nature upon him, and as at this time to be born of a pure virgin; Grant that we being regenerate, and made thy children by adoption and grace, may daily be renewed by thy Holy Spirit; through the same our Lord Jesus Christ, who liveth and reigneth with thee and the same Spirit ever, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

The reading for the Epistle comes the Revelation of Saint John the Divine, the Fourteenth Chapter, beginning at the First Verse:

I LOOKED, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads. And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder: and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps: and they sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four living creatures, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred and forty and four thousand, which were redeemed from the earth. These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth. These were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb. And in their mouth was found no guile: for they are without fault before the throne of God.

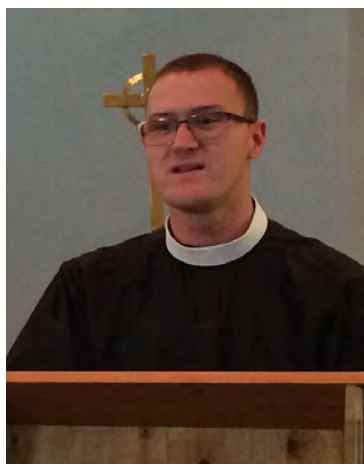
The Gospel for today came from the Gospel according to Saint Matthew, the Second Chapter, beginning at the Thirteenth Verse:

THE angel of the Lord appeareth to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and flee into Egypt, and be thou there until I bring thee word: for Herod will seek the young child to destroy him. When he arose, he took the young child and his mother by night, and departed into Egypt: and was there until the death of Herod: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Out of Egypt have I called my son. Then Herod, when he saw that he was mocked of the wise men, was exceeding wrath, and sent forth, and slew all the children that were in Bethlehem, and in all the coasts thereof, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had diligently enquired of the wise men. Then was fulfilled that which was spoken by Jeremy the prophet, saying, In Rama was there a voice heard, lamentation, and weeping, and great mourning, Rachel weeping for her children, and would not be comforted, because they are not.

Sermon - Rev Jack Arnold

Church of the Faithful Centurion - Descanso, California

At this Christmastide, we have been concentrating on the joy of the Christ's coming to earth; rightly so! But, in our liturgical calendar, the days go on. Right after Christmas, we celebrate Boxing Day in the Anglican tradition, but more than that 26 December brings us the recollection of Saint Steven Deacon and Martyr. Steven was killed under the direction of Saul of Tarsus, the same person who with God's Grace and Help became Saint Paul. The following day, 27 December, recalls Saint John, the longest lived of the Apostles whose writing gives so much to the theology of the New Testament. That brings us to today, 28 December, when we recall The Holy Innocents, whose deaths are connected with Jesus' birth.



An odd combination of days and thoughts for those who do not choose to think or delve deeply into a subject upon which their eternal lives are dependent. Most people, if they go to church are Creastors, that is people who attend church on Christmas and Easter. This is certainly better than not at all, but one wonders why the two major events of the Christian year do not inspire them to more in depth immersion. As ministers, I guess most of us

wonder why we cannot get the message across. Still other people, members of churches, come every Sunday, so long as it is convenient. That is certainly better yet, but their knowledge falls short of the information available in the Bible. While the Book of Common Prayer is a wonder, it only provides propers for the Sundays and Holy Days, the subject matter is limited to the 52 high points if you make every Sunday! Often parishes overlook inconvenient days, such as Holy Innocents, or even worse the Circumcision. They only fall on a Sunday every seven years and who will know, anyway?

So, precisely what is The Holy Innocents? Why is it important? Start with the Gospel we just heard from Saint Matthew:

Herod, when he saw that he was mocked of the wise men, was exceeding wroth, and sent forth, and slew all the children that were in Bethlehem, and in all the coasts thereof, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had diligently enquired of the wise men. (Matt 2)

Herod was certainly not a nice fellow, he ordered his own sons killed in another incident and in fact, one of his own sons was among those who were murdered in this event. Macrobius (c. 395-423), writes in his Saturnalia: "When he [emperor Augustus] heard that among the boys in Syria under two years old whom Herod, king of the Jews, had ordered to kill, his own son was also killed, he said: it is better to be Herod's pig, than his son." Even being among Herod's own family was not a sure guarantee of safety, based on his penchant to murder people, even those of his own blood.

Based on the number of people in the area, probably around 1,000, it seems likely that 20 or less children lost their lives in this event. Worldwide it was a minor hiccup; if it was you or your child, the casualties were terrible. The killing of an innocent child, a baby is among the most terrible and heinous of crimes. Christ says that it is better to have a millstone hanged around your neck and be cast into the sea, than to harm one of these precious gifts of God.

I would not like to be among those who murder little children at the Last Judgment, especially those who run and operate abortion clinics. I cannot pretend to know what God will or will not say or judge of these folks, only that I will not want to be in their position when that day arrives.

So, what do we take from this? Well, first there is the historical fact part. Matthew wanted to document what happened. Fair enough.

Why did Herod sacrifice the children? "For the greater good." In this case, his greater good. He did not want this "Messiah" to mess up his gig. He was making a great living out of keeping the Jews under control for the Romans, the last thing he needed was to have some Messiah mess things up. He did not want the Jews to experience the Freedom the "Messiah" would bring; in this case, Jesus would free us from death. Herod was jealous of the title of the "Messiah" and figured incorrectly that Jesus would be competing with him for ruling of the land of Israel. Only Christ rules more than merely just the land of Israel if we let Him, He will rule our hearts with absolute justice.

"For the greater good"² is a concept oft used to justify doing terrible things so that someone else can benefit. Normally the person(s) benefiting in the end are those doing the sacrificing, not being sacrificed. Important difference.

Can you see the similarity between the Holy Innocents being sacrificed for Herod's greater good and the children being thrown to Molech? In the case of Molech, parents threw their first born into the fires of hell to gain earthly riches. Herod directed the murder of children so he could continue his criminal enterprise without interference by a Messiah.

Now, think of the children being murdered in the womb, torn apart while alive, dismembered then thrown in the dumpster so that their parents won't be inconvenienced or punished with a child.

At the very least, if one does not want their child, they should at least put him or her up for adoption to give a family who does want a child a chance at loving the child, they could or would not love. But, alas, think, if one does not want a child, they shouldn't partake in the act that would create the child in the first place! This is why there is an order to the prayer book. First comes Baptism, then Confirmation, then Marriage, then the Birth of a Child and so on till finally the Burial of the Dead. The point is, there is a certain order to life as God has ordained for the successful and fruitful multiplication of this earth, and if anybody performs this order out of sequence, the results could be catastrophic.

Abortion – Holy Innocents – Molech

What is the difference?

Last week in the *On Point* section, Rev Bryan Dabney provided a quote from James Kennedy, an American theologian, teacher and author:

We have been made for eternity! Yet though such a belief exists in every ancient religion from the Egyptians to the Persian to the Assyrian and Babylonian, the Chinese and the Hindu, everywhere it has waited for Jesus Christ to give to it a certitude nothing else could grant.³

While Christ has been present since He made the world, so has evil. As elements of Truth, that is the Christ of God, come out in every religion, so do elements of evil and the Devil. As Christ waxes strong, the Devil of necessity wanes. If we let our faith in Christ wane and our country deviates from the firm foundation upon which it was founded, the Devil gains strength and becomes bolder. The solution to counter Satan is to increase our strength in Christ and embolden others around us to do the same, then for our little part, Satan's hold will diminish.

So, let's quickly talk about the propers. In the Collect, we find ourselves asking to emulate children in their simple steadfast faith even unto death. For only by simple faith in our Lord can we enter into heaven. Faith as of children, accepting our Lord for what He is, not what we want to make Him. For He is the Maker, not us!

When John talks about the 144,000, they are, symbolic or actual, the essence of the children who have gone before us. Simple faith and without fault at the Father's Throne.

The Gospel, a straight forward historical rendition, shows how important it is to act on God's instruction. Had Joseph not taken Mary and Baby Jesus into Egypt, the story

would have ended right there. But, Joseph acted and the story played out. As Matthew pointed out, this is not the first time children were lost and in numbers. It was important that Jesus not be among them.

Heaven is at the end of an uphill trail. The easy downhill trail does not lead to the summit.

The time is now, not tomorrow. The time has come, indeed. How will you ACT?

It is by our actions we are known.

Sanctity of Life Sunday

Sanctity of Life⁴ Sunday can be celebrated on the Sunday closest to Holy Innocents; this year is on the 28th of December.

Every human life is important to God, although sadly, not every life has value in our society. We devalue human lives when we abort our unborn children. Fifty million babies have been destroyed by abortion since Roe v. Wade made abortion legal in America 41 years ago. New methods of earlier pre-natal testing have contributed to the rise in abortions (nearly 90%) of unborn children diagnosed with Down syndrome. Their lives are deemed insignificant simply because they possess an extra chromosome!

In China and India thousands of female babies are aborted because sons are valued more.

God values every human life and as Christ's followers we ought to treat every human life as significant. Historically the Christian church has always confessed that The Triune God is our Maker. We are fearfully and wonderfully formed by God. We are not merely chance happenings of the universe. As human beings we are distinct from the rest of creation—made in God's very image and likeness (Gen. 1:26-27; 9:6).

With the church throughout history, we affirm that God is the Creator of each human life and that every life has significance in His eyes.

The faithful church must gather round the pregnant mothers in its midst and gathers around every person and family with special needs, cherishing every life that God has entrusted to their care.

Holy Innocents. What does that really mean? In the case of the young boys, two years and younger, in the area around Bethlehem, would be executed because a mad (crazy) ruler was fearful of losing his throne to a child who was prophesied as the King of the Jews. Herod wanted to be known as King of the Jews, he wanted the honor and wealth that came with the title and the authority of that title. So when the Magi came looking for him who was born King of the Jews, he panicked. He had to remove that threat. Herod, was really just an agent for Satan, who had from the Garden been trying to stop the coming Messiah. He, the Messiah, who would put Satan in that final flight pattern of destruction, with his death on the Cross, had to be stopped, as far as Satan was concerned. So in doing Satan's work, Herod had the innocent put to death.

So how does this translate to the wholesale slaughter of innocent babies killed by abortion today? Can we not see the hand of Satan in the attempt to destroy God's creations, by any means possible? This attempt to destroy God's creation whether it be by riotous living, total abandonment of godly ways or by the pre-emptive strike against human kind before that life has a chance to live, all fits the pattern of a fallen angel, who knowing he will one day be defeated, is yet still trying his hardest to take as many with him as possible.

When the government becomes involved in social engineering, whether it be by "limiting" population growth or by taking over the raising of 'holy innocents' in our god-forsaken schools, we as the Church have abandoned the fight if we do not raise a voice of protest. If we do not let our faith be known in this very deadly struggle, then we are just as culpable of causing the deaths of those 'holy innocents'.

What can we do? We can help by supporting those who are fighting on the front lines

against the abortion industry. We can pray. We can talk to others about the total lack of choice the “pro-choice” side really espouses. The innocent baby has NO CHOICE, he or she is killed, they have no choice in the matter. So who is really pro-choice? We can pray for the mothers who have been tricked into thinking that the ending of the life she is carrying is for the good. What good you say? The good of the planet, the good of the mother, the good of society, whatever the latest “good” that is currently being pushed. How about what might be good for the baby? Pray for the right words to say, pray for the right scripture to share, pray for the nation.

Let us look to a few summaries and paraphrases of scripture to see how God views his creation, Mankind. These examples really bring into mind the reality that God does love his creation, so much so, that he sent his Only begotten Son to die for our sins.

Man created in God’s image, God declared his creation, “Very good!”
(Genesis 1:26-31)

For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother’s womb...
(Psalm 139:1 4-17)

You shall not murder.
(Deuteronomy 5:17)

Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you.

(Isaiah 44:2)

The Lord called me from the womb, from the body of my mother, he called me.

This is the story of Hagar’s “crisis pregnancy” and how God, El Shaddai or “The God who sees,” meets the needs of a woman seeking help.

Here we find Jesus’ criteria for how we care for “the least of these.”
(Matthew 25:31-46)

Rescue those being led away to death; hold back those staggering toward slaughter. If you say, “But we knew nothing about this,” does not He who weighs the heart perceive it? Does not he who guards your life know it? Will he not repay each person according to what he has done?
(Proverbs 24:1-12)

Stop doing wrong, learn to do right! Seek justice, encourage the oppressed. Defend the cause of the fatherless; plead the case of the widow.
(Isaiah 1:17)

Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world.
(James 1:27)

Jesus says, "I tell you the truth, whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for me."

(Matthew 25:45)

Let us not forget the Holy Innocents. May God give us the courage to fight the good fight against that which is evil. May we live our lives as faithful believers, able to speak to the lost by our actions and our words. We need to be there for those who have no one to speak for them.

Rev Bryan Dabney of Saint John's Sunday Sermon

We are fortunate to have Bryan's Sunday Sermon. If you want people to come to The Truth, you have to speak the truth, expound the truth and live the truth. This is really a good piece and I commend it to your careful reading.



First Sunday after Christmas

In the Gospel according to Saint Matthew, Chapter One, Verse Twenty-Three:

²³Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.

we were given the account of the birth and naming of our Lord wherein the apostle cited the words of the prophet Isaiah: Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel (7:14b). The name Emmanuel— or Immanuel— means God with us and is instructive as it made plain the intention of God to enter our world and to dwell among men so that he might bring them his redeeming grace. But to accomplish that redemption, he first had to clothe himself as a man in the flesh. He came in this manner to serve as a sacrifice so that those who would believe on him might have eternal life in his coming kingdom.

Surprisingly, quite a number of folks today will miss the truth recited by Isaiah and repeated by St. Matthew. While many of them may know the story of Jesus, they do not accept him as the only begotten Son of God. Some will claim that he was but a man and nothing more. All those stories of his divinity are but figments of an over-active imagination. Others may accept him as an idealistic teacher, but one who is nonetheless dead and not coming back.

And so because they believe as they do, Christmas is just another day off from work, or a holiday dedicated to some mythical personality, and not the ever living Son of God. They will then miss the essence of Christ which is after all the real reason for this season. Oh, they'll exchange presents and may even sing a Christmas carol or two. Perhaps they will attend church with family, and begrudgingly listen to a sermon concerning the Christ-child. But it will all be to no effect. They will come away as unconvinced as ever, particularly if they happen to attend some roadshowesque auditorium worship service where reverence for God has been set aside for entertainment and the cult of personality. They may even attend a church that has become so ritualized and emptied of the Holy Spirit that the best the minister can do is read from a child's story book concerning Christmas rather than read from the Scriptures and exposit to the congregation about the necessity for our Lord ever coming in the first place. So what are these folk really missing? They are missing heaven! And all who die without Christ will suffer an eternity without Christ.

But such does not have to be their fate. Our Lord has called upon all true and faithful Christians to be ambassadors and witnesses on his behalf. We are to proclaim the gospel message and make disciples wherever and whenever we can per the permission of the Holy Ghost. We are to have an answer for the faith which is within us should we be questioned by those of the unregenerated. God sent his Son into the world, that the world through him might be saved. Not the world system, but the inhabitants thereof (St. John 3:16-21). We should avoid the trap of attempting to save the world which the scriptures clearly speak against.

Rev EM Bounds noted in his work, Guide To Spiritual Warfare, “the purpose of the church of God is... to regenerate and sanctify the individual, to prepare him by purifying and training him for the high pursuits of eternal life. The church is like a net cast into the sea... [whose] purpose is not to change the sea but to catch fish out of the sea. Let the sea roll on its essential nature while the net catches its fishes... To attempt to save the world while ignoring the individual is not only Utopian but also destructive... To save the world sounds... commendable... but it will result in making the church worldly and unfit for her holy and sublime mission. Christ said that gaining the world and saving the man are opposing objectives (see Matthew 16:26).”

Clearly, we who have been regenerated by the Holy Spirit are called to be witnesses not alchemists. We cannot change the world system dominated by Satan any more than Medieval alchemists could change lead into gold. So then let us keep to those things that we can do, and leave the rest to the Master’s capable hands.

Christmas is indeed a time of giving, but we need to understand the truth behind the season. Our gracious and loving God has given us a gift of inestimable value which he expects us to accept and then use throughout our lives. St. Paul taught that, Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) and hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: that in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is a gift of God: not of works, lest any man should boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them (Ephesians 2:5-10).

We who are born again of the Spirit have been saved with a mighty salvation. God the Father, because of his love for us, sent his only begotten Son to be sin for us. Without his first coming as that babe in Bethlehem— who grew to manhood, who faced the same temptations we have faced and did not give in, and who died for us on Calvary’s cross— we would still be in our sins and trespasses with no hope of ever being freed from this body of sin and death. Only by means of his coming in the flesh, born of a pure virgin, would the promise of our redemption be made manifest. As we continue on through this season of Christmas, let us remember and give thanks to God for his gift to us and remember that Jesus Christ is truly God with us.

Let us pray,

FATHER, we thank you for your gift to us of the Christ-child: who grew to become our Saviour; and we further ask for a wise and understanding heart so that we might better witness of him to those who are as yet in the grip of the evil one, that they might eventually turn unto him and be saved; all of which we ask in the name of him whom the Scriptures call Emmanuel, even Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*
