Propers

Each Sunday there are Propers: special prayers and readings from the Bible. There is a Collect for the Day; that is a single thought prayer, most written either before the refounding of the Church of England in the 1540s or written by Bishop Thomas Cranmer, the first Archbishop of Canterbury after the re-founding.

The Collect for the Day is to be read on Sunday and during Morning and Evening Prayer until the next Sunday. The Epistle is normally a reading from one of the various Epistles, or letters, in the New Testament. The Gospel is a reading from one of the Holy Gospels, Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. The Collect is said by the minister as a prayer, the Epistle can be read by either a designated reader (as we do in our church) or by one

of the ministers and the Holy Gospel, which during the service in our church is read by an ordained minister.

The propers are the same each year, except if a Red Letter Feast, that is one with propers in the prayerbook, falls on a Sunday, then those propers are to be read instead, except in a White Season, where it is put off. Red Letter Feasts, so called because in the Altar Prayerbooks the titles are in red, are special days. Most of the Red Letter Feasts are dedicated to early saints instrumental in the development of the church, others to special events. Some days are particularly special and the Collect for that day is to be used for an octave (eight days) or an entire season, like Advent or Lent.

The Propers for today are found on Page 214-215, with the Collect first:

The Seventeenth Sunday after Trinity.

The Collect.

LCORD, we pray thee that thy grace may always prevent¹ and follow us, and make us continually to be given to all good works; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen*.

The Epistle for today came from the letter of Saint Paul to the Ephesians beginning at the First Verse of the Fourth Chapter. Once again, Paul calls us to a new life, different from our old life. A life in which we act in a manner worthy of the better life to which we have been called by Christ and for which He gave His life. Paul, of all people, knows the importance of setting aside your old life, as Saul did, so that as Paul he asks us to put God first in our lives, to put ourselves last. He reminds us, "There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all." The key to a successful life is to put the important things at the top of your To Do List. And, notice it is a To Do List, not a To Think About or To Wait a While List. What is more important than God?

THEREFORE, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called, with all lowliness and meekness, with long-suffering, for-bearing one another in love; endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all².

Today's Holy Gospel came from the Fourteenth Chapter of the Gospel of St. Luke, beginning at the First Verse. The Gospel starts out reminding us the Law was designed to be flexible. The goal is to do God's will, not to "follow the letter of the law" as the Pharisees were so keen on. They brought before Him a man in need of healing as they sat to eat on the Sabbath Day. They watched to see what He would do. Putting the monkey on their back, He asked, "Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath Day?" Wishing to be in a position to criticize rather than answer, "they held their peace." He healed the man, then asked them, "Which of you shall have an ass or an ox fallen into a pit, and will not straightway pull him out on the Sabbath Day?" They would not respond; for the answer was obvious.

¹ Prevent is a word that has many uses, and at least one has fallen out of general usage as time has gone on. This is one of them. In this case the word prevent means *to go before*. Seventeenth Sunday after Trinity Saint Andrew's Anglican Orthodox Church 27 September 2015, Anno Domini

The Seventeenth Sunday after Trinity.

The Collect.

LORD, we pray thee that thy grace may always prevent and follow us, and make us continually to be given to all good works; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen*.

And it came to pass, as he went into the house of one of the chief Pharisees to eat bread on the sabbath day, that they watched him. And, behold, there was a certain man before him which had the dropsy. And Jesus answering spake unto the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath day? And they held their peace. And he took him, and healed him, and let him go; And answered them, saying, Which of you shall have an ass or an ox fallen into a pit,

and will not straightway pull him out on the sabbath day? And they could not answer him again to these things. And he put forth a parable to those which were bidden, when he marked how they chose out the chief rooms; saying unto them, When thou art bidden of any man to a wedding, sit not down in the highest room; lest a more honourable man than thou be bidden of him; And he that bade thee and him come and say to thee, Give this man place; and thou begin with shame to take the lowest room. But when thou art bidden, go and sit down in the lowest room; that when he that bade thee cometh, he may say unto thee, Friend, go up higher: then shalt thou have worship in the presence of them that sit at meat with thee. For whosoever exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted. (Luke 14:1-11)

It was the Sabbath Day.

"We have been thinking and speaking of a miracle done on the Sabbath. It is evident that our Saviour had a preference for the Sabbath as a time for working miracles. How, then, is it with respect to ourselves — we who, many of us, would be glad to have a miracle wrought on our behalf, and yet have no right whatever to expect one? It is just thus — we are waiting for the Sabbath. In other words, it was intended, no doubt, to be taught us by our Saviour's practice, that there is a special time of rest coming, when all the various troubles that hamper and injure us will be utterly removed — our burdens unbound; our fevers cooled for ever; our weakness changed to strength; all our heaviness lightened; our blind eyes made clear; our deaf ears unstopped; our feet filled with vigorous leaping blood; and all that is within us lighted up with joy, even as the house was lighted up, and music and dancing sounded in it, when the prodigal came home. There is a Sabbath coming; and as Christ wrought His cures upon the Sabbath, when He was upon earth, we are taught to look on to a day of cure that is coming that Sabbath, namely, of rest, into which we hope to enter hereafter. It may be needful for our perfection, and the perfection of our friends, that we should still be burdened; but we are quite sure that, after the round of the six days, there will come the seventh; we are quite sure, when the time of trial has ended, the boon of health will be granted." (Rev T. T. Lynch)

Jesus has been invited to the house of a prominent Pharisee one of the chief of them, we are told. Other Pharisees have been invited as well for the purpose of trying to find some fault in Jesus whereby they might condemn Him.

"And it came to pass, as he went into the house of one of the chief Pharisees to eat bread on the sabbath day, that they watched him."

Many other of the Pharisees were doubtless there for "they watched him." How greatly would they have benefitted if they had watched Him to learn instead of to find fault.

Why was Jesus invited by one of those who hated Him and were constantly trying to destroy Him? They had invited Jesus to catch Him in an act of disobedience of the Sabbath – it was a 'set up' in the popular vernacular.

Why do you suppose Jesus accepted the invitation? Jesus was no recluse – He came to help all who would hear Him. He loved to be in social gatherings where men would listen – ALL men…even Pharisees.

"And, behold, there was a certain man before him which had the dropsy."

The cunning mind of the Pharisee bypassed no opportunity in providing a means of entrapment for Christ. Seemingly, just by coincidence, a man with a grave and serious malady is present – a man who probably had not been invited had it not fit comfortably in the plans of the Pharisees to present Jesus with a temptation.

These men are ruthless. They will use even the kindness and compassion of Jesus to try and condemn Him.

They have seated the man with the dropsy (congestive heart failure) in a place BEFORE Jesus. They know that He loves to heal and to do good regardless the occasion, but today is the Sabbath! They will use this as an occasion to condemn Christ of violating the Sabbath by doing healing works on this day.

But Jesus knows the heart of men, and He knows the evil thoughts of the hearts of those who sit watching Him.

"And Jesus answering spake unto the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath day?"

Jesus sets the circumstances to turn the tables on these miscreants. The question restated might read: "Is it ever unlawful to do good?" Did God provide man with the day of rest for the purpose of omitting even deeds of kindness?

The Pharisees and priests of Jesus day had added so many cumbersome proscriptions to the Sabbath observance and every other aspect of the law, that men could not bear them without misery – just the opposite of what God had intended.

Jesus was continually tempted in every way that we are tempted, but Jesus never gave into temptation except in certain cases.

What were those cases? When tempted to do good, as in the present case, Christ could not resist the temptation to act out of His compassion to heal and to comfort. This was not a temptation to sin, but a temptation by sinful men of Christ to do good. He always did!

You and I are tempted, on the other hand, to do bad things not pleasing to God. But in every temptation to do evil is found an opportunity to, instead, do good. Jesus sets the example for us in every case.

Because they have set their trap, the Pharisees do not respond to the pointed question of Christ: "And they held their peace." Men will most often speak out when they can condemn or hurt, but will less often speak out on the part of righteousness. Political correctness restrains them from speaking righteousness but tends always to wickedness.

So Jesus poses the simple question which they decline to answer so as not to give away their plot. How many clergy, as well as laity, remain silent on issues of great importance? I have observed the silence, even on discussion groups of the church, remain stony silent on matters on which they should have strong opinion. The silence of those is like a scream in the night.

Legalists often forget that the Sabbath was made for man and not man for the Sabbath. (Mark 2:27)

The failure to accept the Sabbath in the manner and purpose for which it was given nullifies its benefits. The Christian Sabbath is not a once per week observance but a daily one. Christ has given us an Eternal Sabbath (Rest).

"And he took him, and healed him, and let him go." The whole will of Christ was to heal the man and not to make a spectacle of him. So Jesus, instead of having the man remain standing by for show, releases him to go his way. How different from the Pharisees who heartlessly brought the man to tempt Christ.

"And answered them, saying, Which of you shall have an ass or an ox fallen into a pit, and will not straightway pull him out on the sabbath day?"

Had they forgotten the counsel of Proverbs 12:11 - "A righteous man regardeth the life of his beast: but the tender mercies of the wicked are cruel."

An ox or a donkey were precious to men who depended on them to produce income. If one of the Pharisees own precious animals fell into a ditch on the Sabbath, he would certainly have rescued the animal, if not out of kindness, then out of greed.

He thus shuts them. Up to this startling alternative: "Not to do good, when it is in the power of our hand to do it, is to do evil; not to save life, when we can, is to kill"

Righteous words will shut the mouth of the wicked.

Jesus is an observer of men and women. He watched as the poor widow cast her all into the Temple treasury, and He has observed here how the guests of the Pharisee came into the room and chose the best seats and provisions. They sought to have their seating lend them honor when they should have allowed their honor to determine their seating. They lacked humility and were filled with false pride.

So Jesus tells them a story (Parable) to which they can relate in common life:

"When thou art bidden of any man to a wedding, sit not down in the highest room; lest a more honourable man than thou be bidden of him; And he that bade thee and him come and say to thee, Give this man place; and thou begin with shame to take the lowest room. But when thou art bidden, go and sit down in the lowest room; that when he that bade thee cometh, he may say unto thee, Friend, go up higher: then shalt thou have worship in the presence of them that sit at meat with thee."

All of the counsels of Christ are full of spiritual and uplifting truths. This short Parable is no exception.

Jesus begins the story with a delicate allusion to a type of gathering that would be different from that of his present host of whom He has been invited. The venue is a wedding feast, but still a feast so that the same principle will apply.

When we are invited to a special event, do not exalt your importance by finding the highest place, or most visible place, to stand or sit. We will inevitably to be embarrassed by our presumptive pride when we are told, curtly, to move and surrender your place to one having greater honor than you. The only place left at that time will be the place of least honor – the lowest room. "And he that bade thee and him come and say to thee, Give this man place; and thou begin with shame to take the lowest room."

He has given an example of how not to behave, but He does not leave us in doubt as to how we should behave: "But when thou art bidden, go and sit down in the lowest room; that when he that bade thee cometh, he may say unto thee, Friend, go up higher: then shalt thou have worship in the presence of them that sit at meat with thee."

Notice the host refers to the man who is humble and takes the very lowest place of honor as Friend. He did not refer to the man who took the highest place as Friend. Men despise false pride and arrogance in others. If we humble ourselves, men will always elevate us in esteem. But greater is the reward in Heaven!

A college professor once hosted a tea for his graduating students. When they all presented themselves at his home, the professor had all the cups, in the right number, assembled on the table. The cups were all of different kinds. One was of stone, one of crystal, one of clay, and some were shaped curiously different from any before seen. When the professor invited the students to take a cup, the first took the crystal, the next the glass, the next the stone, the next the clay, and so forth.

As the professor watched them drink their tea that he had poured for them, he observed that they had each chosen the best cup at the table; but the purpose of a tea was not the kind of cup one drank from, but the tea which the cup contained. The quality of the tea is not changed by the quality of the cup which contains it. So with our worthiness before God. it is not some superficial position or appearance that is important, but what is inside our hearts – the Temple of the Living God!

Church Service in Dayton, Ohio 91st Tactical Fighter Squadron Chuck Magsig, Presiding

As some of you may be aware, the Arnolds, Hap, Dru and Jack were all on travel to Dayton, Ohio for Thursday through Sunday evening for a reunion of the 91st Tactical Fighter Squadron, 81st Tactical Fighter Wing, RAF Bentwaters. The reunion was for the F-101 and F-4 crews who were stationed there during the Cold War for the years 1960-1979. It was a unique squadron in a unique place at a unique point and time and the people have stayed in touch.

We bring it up because none of us were particularly religious at the time. One might say the crews were pretty much non-religious. We had only one known atheist, but the rest of us, while "good" Jews or Christians, probably even conversant in the basics of "our" religion did not really live that life at all. Actually, we did have one pilot who at least on the surface lived, or at least talked, the Christian life, but he killed himself later so it seem there were problems in his world, too.

But as time has gone on, many of us have been fortunate to live long enough to find out like John Newton that without our Lord, we are lost; with Him we are found. For whatever reason, the hardest chargers, the leaders of iniquity became the strongest followers. That seems to have been a common thread throughout history, from David, to Saul/Paul. It does take a special type of person to lay their life on the line every day, Rev Hap points out that thirty percent of the pilots he flew with died in aircraft, others sustained serious debilitating injuries. Perhaps if we had been stronger, we could have found a different way to cope, but we did not.

As time went on, some of us managed to find our way to the Lord. His Light had always been on, we finally saw it. Of the 90 people at the reunion, five of the most able warriors had entered the ministry. It is interesting that of the 90 aircrew and family members present, 26 of them managed to wake up early on the Sunday departure day to attend a church service lead by Chuck Magsig. Chuck was once the *Blue Mags*, an almost caricature of the fighter pilot, back in the ancient past one of our informal leaders, a pilot who anyone would follow to the Gates of Hell, just to see what would happen, just for fun.

Chuck gave an incredibly effective talk on what it means to be a Christian and how to do it! While in a sense he was preaching to the choir, he reached every heart there and that is no simple task. Varied backgrounds with amazing intellects and he hit every heart.



In 1975, The Blue Mags, who, like all of us at the time, had grown up in the church and rationalize the church could wait while he did "important" things, was coming back home on an airliner seated next to an NFL player who shared his life in Christ with The Blue Mags. That chance meeting hit his heart and he came down the bottom of the airstairs as Chuck, The Blue Mags stayed on board. He shared his new life with his wife, who thought she should join him. As a human, he succeeded and failed; up and down. He could not keep on course, he read the Bible, but it just did not sink it. Until he came to David; God's favored who failed so badly until he asked for and received a new and contrite heart. Just like Paul's New Man, we need a New Heart to live in Christ.

Chuck's service or talk covered more, but we wanted to share that one point with you.

Sermon – Reverend Jack Arnold - Time and Action Church of the Faithful Centurion - Descanso, California

Today's sermon tied the Collect, Epistle and Gospel together and talked, as is oft the case, of the need for action, not simply diction.

Consider the words of the Collect, "... thy grace may always prevent and follow us, and make us continually to be given to all good works ..."

The first thing to consider when you look at today's Collect is a word: prevent. Prevent is a word that has many uses, and at least one has fallen out of general usage as time has gone on. This is one of them. In this case the word prevent means to go before. Before you object to archaic words, consider this is a current word, it just has a use you may not have been aware of and now you are! What a bonus for this week!

So, we ask God that His Grace, His Love, His Power, His Help may go before and after us to protect us and guide us that we might desire to do what He wants us to do. Pretty much a re-wording of a lot of the Collects. Why would that be? Pretty simple, our biggest failing is we are wont to do what we want! This is a very common theme in the

collects and lessons in the lectionary, for a very good reason. It is is our sinful nature that we have that causes us to want to do what we want. As we are creatures that have free will and are not wont to exercise it for God or good. That is a very dangerous combination, as my father says often. That is not the same as doing what will provide us with the best result. The difference is that God truly knows what is best for us. And that if we follow what He wants for us, we are guaranteed to have food results in the long run. It does not mean that we will not suffer in the short term, however it means that if we follow God's will for us, then we will come out ahead in the end, when we have eternal life. If we follow our natural inclination, we will not like the end result, that is eternal separation from God. We are like disobedient children, and God is the ever patient Father. But, from time to time, we will make mischief and or trouble, some of us more than others. God has to gently warn us and allow us to experience the consequences of our inclination to sin, in order to learn not to do it. This is His form of discipline in a way. When bad things happen as a result of our doing, it is not His fault that's it happened, but our fault for not having done what we were supposed to be doing because it was too difficult. Through consequences of our sinful actions, we know that we shouldn't do it again. We know, often very clearly, what we want. For example, one morning I started to lead the Order of Morning Prayer. My first inclination was to do it without looking at the rubrics. But after thinking a moment, I realized that this was a mistake, as the rubrics are there to guide the minister in leading the service. While I was studying for my WGU degrees, I found that if I didn't adhere to the task rubrics when writing papers, I got my tasks sent back revision. However, when I did follow them, I passed. So I ended up putting the rubrics in a document and writing around them, to make sure I followed them. Like the rubrics, God knows, always very clearly, what we need. But we do not often know what God wants for us, so we have to first pray to Him to find out what He wants, then the most critical step of the communications is that we have to listen to What he says. He is there, like the rubrics to guide us along our paths in our daily life. So, we need to ask God every day, every time, for help to do our duty.

So, what does Paul tell us in his letter to us? Once again, he calls us to a new life, different from our old life. We shed our old clothes, as it were, like reptiles shedding their old skin and put on the brand new armor of light, new helmet, new boots and new everything. A life in which we act in a manner worthy of the better life to which we have been called by Christ and for which He gave His life. We are to act in accordance with the new way in which life, to desist from sinning and to do good things for people and for Him. The part about cease and desisting from sin is one of the most difficult aspects of putting aside ones old life. But it can be done. Paul, formerly Saul did it, and went on to become one of the greatest apostles that served the Lord. So if he can do it, so can we. And it is made possible by the Holy Ghost, who is our lifeline to God our Father. Paul, of all people, knows the importance of setting aside your old life, as Saul did, so that as Paul he asks us to put God first in our lives, to put ourselves last. He even changed his name to reflect his state as a new man under Our Lord's leadership. He reminds us, "There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all." The key to a successful life is to put the important things at the top of your To Do List. And, notice it is a To Do List, not a To Think About or To Wait a While List. It is not a I'll Get a Round To It List, or What I Don't Want to Do List. What is more important than God? It is all about prioritization, putting God ahead of your wants and desires. We have to make it so that serving God is our want and desire, then and only then are our desires aligned with His. We have to accept the

Holy Ghost into our lives to do this, then when we truly have faith, it will show in our actions. Action and not diction is what truly counts in the end. It is a phase that shows up in the sermons a lot, but that is only because it is very true.

When Luke relates the parable of the feast, it is more than just a sitting diagram. I liken it to the tale of the publican and the Pharisee. When Christ talks about the man who exalts himself and sits too high at the wedding and thus must be abased. That would be the Pharisee. When Christ then talks about the man who sits low, and is raised to the higher station, I think of the publican, who smote his breast and would not even look up his eyes to heaven. We have to be the publican in our dealings with God, rather than our natural tendency of being the Pharisee. We should not be one of those selfish individuals who always causes grief for others because he is blind to his own faults and only thinks of himself. Again as with the ceasing from sin, this is one of the hardest things we have to do. But it must be done, no matter how we feel about it. So let us turn to our Lord to help with it, because He alone can help us. He can truly help us, if we are truly willing with our hearts, souls and minds. We have to be willing to act and do actions, and not just say it. No other expert can help us, no "theologian" or prosperity preacher can truly provide for our needs better than Our Lord. If we do what God asks, we will not become like those people. If we put God's will before ours, the welfare of those we encounter before ours, if we hold open the door as gentlepersons are wont to do for others, we will find we are doing what God would have us do and enjoying it. And that is the best gift of all, the joy one gets from serving others is true happiness.

It is very possible to do the good deeds and have fun doing them. The week we spent in worship with the other ministers and their wives at the AOC Convention proves this. Doing good things for other people and being with other believers gives me some of the greatest happiness I have ever felt. This comes from the Holy Ghost, from being inspired by Him, around other believers. Wherever two or three or gathered, Christ is there also. It is a wonderful feeling wherever He is.

Heaven is at the end of an uphill trail. The easy downhill trail does not lead to the summit.

The time is now, not tomorrow. The time has come, indeed. How will you ACT? It is by our actions we are known.

Bishop Dennis Campbell's Sermon

Bishop Dennis is a brilliant speaker. He is able to take biblical precepts and make them


perfectly understandable, even to me. Oft he provides the text of his sermons and I take the utmost pleasure in passing them on:



Today is the third and final sermon on the "blood moon" that so many are talking and preaching and blogging about. I have explained what is meant by the



term, "blood moon" in the previous two sermons, so, today I will attempt to expound some of the Biblical verses which the blood moon people believe teaches their view.



The first verse is Genesis 1:14. Here God says, "Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night, and let them be for signs and for seasons, and for days, and for years." According to the blood moon people, this means the celestial bodies are signs of events that will take place on the earth. Thus, eclipses, meteors, and comets, and such are signs from God. But is that what this verse means? Let me try to show three ways in which the heavenly bodies are signs, according to this verse.

First, they mark the seasons, days, and years, of earth. They mark the annual seasons of spring, summer, autumn and winter. The course of the sun from east to west marks a day. The course of the the sun from

north to south and back marks a year. The course of the moon and stars mark a night. The course of the moon through its phases marks a lunar month. These are the seasons and days and years of Genesis 1:14.

Second, the celestial bodies mark the various festivals and seasons required by the Old Testament. Israel's calendar was both lunar and solar based, and most of the feasts and holy days were scheduled to coincide with the phases of the moon. Passover, for example began on the first full moon after the vernal equinox. So the moon and sun are signs, or markers, for the Old Testament religious events. These, too, are the seasons, days, and years of Genesis 1:14.

It is important we understand these Old Testament events have passed away. I don't mean they are not observed anymore. Obviously, many Jews still observe them, and there is a growing movement among Christians to reinstate and observe them. I mean they have been superseded. They pointed to the ministry of the Messiah, and to His formation of the New Israel, which is the New Testament Church. They were shadows of things to come, according to Colossians 2:17. That's why Paul warned Christians to "Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days. The meat and drink are the Old Testament dietary laws. Holydays and new moons are the Old Testament festivals, like Passover and the Day of Atonement. Sabbaths also refer to holy days and holy seasons, not The Sabbath. All of these things are shadows, but Christ is the body (Col. 2:16, 17). They are shadows, but Christ is the real thing. Because they are shadows, we don't have to concern ourselves with their observance any more. In fact, Colossians was written to refute those who were observing them, and trying to convince others to observe them. Paul takes up the same theme in Galatians. "I am afraid of you," he wrote in Galatians 4:11. In modern English we would say, "I am afraid for you. Why is Paul afraid for the Galatians? He is afraid his work among them is in vain. He fears they are not really Christians. He fears they do not really understand the Gospel. Why? because they want to observe the Old Testament "days, and months, and times, and years" (Gal. 4:10). They want to put their faith in the things that foreshadowed Christ, instead of in Christ Himself.

There is yet a third way in which the celestial bodies are signs. They show the glory of God. According to Psalm 19:1, the heavens declare His glory. They tell us that the One

who made them is great beyond our imagination. According to Romans 1:20, the whole creation reveals God's existence, power, and Godhead. In this way, the celestial bodies are signs, but not of events; they are signs that point us to God.

The celestial bodies, then, are for signs for the earthly seasons, signs for Old Testament festival and holy days and seasons, and signs of the glory of God. Genesis 1:14 does not mean they are prophetic signs of future events.

A second passage, often quoted by these people, is Joel 2:30-31; "And I will show wonders in the heavens and in the earth, blood, and fire, and pillars of smoke. The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and terrible day of the Lord come." At first glance, these words seem to support the view of the blood moon people, don't they? They even say the moon will be turned into blood. Of course, we all realise the moon will not literally turn into human blood; this is symbolic language, and the problem we have with it is understanding what it symbolises. The blood moon people say it refers to total lunar eclipses, especially the one happening tonight, because it is a sign from God that something is going to happen. Most of them say that "something" is the "rapture," but some think it signals something else. Let me try to explain what this passage means in Joel.

In Joel, Israel has fallen into sin, again, and God has sent them a prophet to warn them that He will punish them if they do not repent. How will that punishment come? Invasion. Locusts represent an invading army that will descend upon them like the locusts in the plagues of Egypt. The darkened sun refers to the dust of marching armies and the smoke of burning cities, so thick it blocks the sun's light. The moon turned to blood signifies war and bloodshed. So much blood is shed it is as though the very moon is red with it. Isaiah knew the book of Joel, and he knew its meaning. So, when he quotes Joel in chapter 12, he is warning Judah that an army is preparing to invade it. In Isaiah, the falling stars and darkened sun and moon still mean what they meant in Joel. They are conquest and burning and death. It is as though the heavenly bodies join God in punishing Israel by refusing to give their light and joy to the Jews (Is. 12:4-10). Thus, these words are not about eclipses. They are the wrath of God. They are wars and blood and death.

Our Lord quotes Joel in His warning about the destruction of Jerusalem in Matthew 24:30. There Joel's words are symbols of Christ coming to Jerusalem to inaugurate the new era of the Day of the Lord, or, the Church age, which begins on Pentecost (Acts 2:16-21). In this new era, the old things will pass away. They will be like stars falling from the heavens, and like the sun and moon going dark. But, as in Joel, they also point to war. Matthew 24 records Christ's answer to the disciples' question about the coming fall of Jerusalem and destruction of the Temple. It will be a war so destructive that the smoke rising from the burning city will darken the sun. It will be a war so violent it is as though the very moon itself runs red with human blood.

A third passage thought to teach the blood moon theory is Revelation 6:11-17. Here, again, the smoke of burning buildings and terrible bloodshed are symbolised. Chapter 6 opens the sixth seal of Revelation What has been happening in the book to this point? War and pestilence. The four horsemen have been sent to earth. One rides a white horse and goes forth conquering and to conquer. One rides a red horse, and takes peace from the earth, that people should kill one another. One rides a black horse and brings famine and starvation. And one rides a pale horse. His name is Death. Hell follows him, and he is given power to kill with the sword, and hunger, and death, and wild beasts.

"The sixth seal continues to rain wrath upon Jerusalem (Rev. 6:12-17). This seal brings fearful catastrophes in the heavens and on earth. Earthquakes rend the ground, the sun goes dark, the moon turns to blood, and stars fall from the sky. Again we must remember that these are symbols. Like the four horsemen, they represent something else. To understand their meaning we must turn to Genesis 1:16.... In Genesis we find this clue, that the sun rules the day and the moon rules the night. Later in Genesis we see stars bowing down to Joseph (Gen. 9:11) representing the members of his family bowing to him. In Rev. 9:2, a falling star represents a being, probably Satan, who is given the keys to the bottomless pit.

These clues reveal the meaning of Rev. 6:14. The celestial bodies represent people. The sun and moon are rulers and leaders. They are the influential people, the religious and civil authorities. Rev. 6:15 confirms this view, for it referrals to the same things that are the subject of verse 14. It speaks of kings and great men, rich men and rulers and mighty men. What are they doing? They are falling from their places. They are ceasing to rule and influence and they are hiding themselves in caves asking the mountains to fall on them.

The meaning of this seal is that great civil disturbances will disrupt the normal life of Jerusalem. Rulers will stop ruling. Law and order will disintegrate, and chaos and anarchy will prevail, leading to widespread suffering and death.

This is exactly what occurred when Rome besieged Jerusalem. Civil authority collapsed, and law and order died. Josephus tells us that the legitimate rulers of Jerusalem were killed or coerced into obedience by groups of criminals he calls robbers. These gangs ruled by force and caused total disruption of the city, stealing and killing as they wished. They usurped both religious and civil authority, even going so far as to ordain their own high priests. The true leaders fell from their places under the robbers' attacks" (He Shall Reign, p. 101).

Before I close today, I want to point out, that when the "blood moon" was spoken or written about in the Bible, it was always done by men who were inspired by God to speak His word. Joel was not giving his opinion; he was giving a warning from God to Israel. Isaiah was not giving his opinion about the moral climate of Jerusalem or the political situation between Israel and other nations. He was giving a warning from God about a very real invasion. Christ is God, the Word become flesh, and He is not giving a human opinion about anything, He is warning the disciples and the Church to flee Jerusalem when they see the Roman army coming because God is going to allow the Romans to destroy the city. The people who are popularising the blood moon idea are not inspired. They are giving their own opinions, as they have the right to do. But having the right to an opinion does not make an opinion right. Therefore let us search the scriptures to see if these things are true. This does not mean to look in the Bible and see if the words these people use are there. It means to look in the Bible and see if the words mean what they say they mean. That is much more difficult to do, yet it must be done with every Bible study, every sermon, and every preacher, including me.

Seventeenth Sunday after Trinity

27 September 2015, AD Psalm 25 • Jeremiah 13:15-21 • Mark 10:35-45

The Seventeenth Sunday after Trinity.

The Collect.

Lprevent³ and follow us, and make us continually to be given to all good works; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen*.

Do we look unto the Lord? Do we trust the Lord? Do we let the Lord show us his ways, his paths? Do we let him lead us in his truth and do we learn from him?



Lots of questions. I know, but not without reason. Are we really following the Lord in our daily lives?

When David was singing this psalm he was singing or preaching to him self. He was asking the Lord to help him, to teach him, to guide him into the path of truth. He knew that God was his salvation. David's supplication to the Lord is for help, being led into truth, and most importantly seeking salvation from God.

Psalm 25. A Psalm of David.

TNTO thee, O LORD, do I lift up my soul.

O my God, I trust in thee: let me not be ashamed, let not mine enemies triumph over me.

- 3 Yea, let none that wait on thee be ashamed: let them be ashamed which transgress without cause.
 - 4 Shew me thy ways, O LORD; teach me thy paths.
- 5 Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day.
- 6 Remember, O LORD, thy tender mercies and thy loving kindnesses; for they have been ever of old.
- 7 Remember not the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions: according to thy mercy remember thou me for thy goodness' sake, O LORD.
 - 8 Good and upright is the LORD: therefore will he teach sinners in the way.
 - 9 The meek will he guide in judgment: and the meek will he teach his way.
- 10 All the paths of the LORD are mercy and truth unto such as keep his covenant and his testimonies.
 - 11 For thy name's sake, O LORD, pardon mine iniquity; for it is great.
 - 12 What man is he that feareth the LORD? him shall he teach in the way that he shall

choose.

- 13 His soul shall dwell at ease; and his seed shall inherit the earth.
- 14 The secret of the LORD is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant.
 - 15 Mine eyes are ever toward the LORD; for he shall pluck my feet out of the net.
 - 16 Turn thee unto me, and have mercy upon me; for I am desolate and afflicted.
 - 17 The troubles of my heart are enlarged: O bring thou me out of my distresses.
 - 18 Look upon mine affliction and my pain; and forgive all my sins.
 - 19 Consider mine enemies; for they are many; and they hate me with cruel hatred.
 - 20 O keep my soul, and deliver me: let me not be ashamed; for I put my trust in thee.
 - 21 Let integrity and uprightness preserve me; for I wait on thee.
 - 22 Redeem Israel, O God, out of all his troubles.

Let' take a look at part of this psalm:

TNTO thee, O LORD, do I lift up my soul.

O my God, I trust in thee: let me not be ashamed, let not mine enemies triumph over me.

- 3 Yea, let none that wait on thee be ashamed: let them be ashamed which transgress without cause.
 - 4 Shew me thy ways, O LORD; teach me thy paths.
- 5 Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day.

In the same manner, David now asks for forgiveness, forgiveness for all that he had done in the past. "...remember not the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions...". That passage is both past and present, David is asking God to forgive his past sins and his current or more recent sins too. When we understand that the memories of past sins are not from the Lord, they are from the god of this world, Satan, then we can step forward, knowing that the Lord has forgiven us. We should trust God to forgive us, he will not hold our sin against us, IF we confess our sin and seek God's forgiveness.

- "...O Lord, have mercy upon us, miserable offenders. Spare thou those, O God, who confess their faults. Restore thou those who are penitent; According to thy promises declared unto mankind in Christ Jesus our Lord..." As quoted from the General Confession of Morning and Evening Prayer. These prayers are direct quotes from the Psalms for the most part, 85 to 90% scripture. These prayers are not made from unknown fabric, they are from the Word of God.
- 6 Remember, O LORD, thy tender mercies and thy lovingkindnesses; for they have been ever of old.
- 7 Remember not the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions: according to thy mercy remember thou me for thy goodness' sake, O LORD.

In our lesson today, taken from Psalm 25, we read that the psalmist is greatly comforted by the mercy of the Lord, knowing the Lord will lift him out of trouble and in all of this, he also waits upon the Lord to do all that He has promised.

Do we have that type of faith?

Do we trust the Lord to lift us up out of the net that entangles us in sin?

Do we trust the Lord to take us out of our distress?

Take the time to read the 25th Psalm. Read it, digest it, inwardly consume it and

meditate on the meaning David is writing to himself and to us down through the ages. Let us pray,

HEAVENLY Father, we humbly beseech thee, to assist us, with thy grace, that we may continue in that holy fellowship, and do all such good works as thou hast prepared for us to walk in; through Jesus Christ our Lord, to whom, with thee and the Holy Ghost, be all honour and glory, world without end. *Amen*.

GRANT, we beseech thee, Almighty God, that the words which we have heard this day with our outward ears, may, through thy grace, be so grafted inwardly in our hearts, that they may bring forth in us the fruit of good living to the honour and praise of thy Name; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen*.

DIRECT us, O Lord in all our doings with thy most gracious favour, and further us with thy continual help, that in all our works begun, continued, and ended in thee we may glorify thy holy Name and finally, by thy mercy, obtain everlasting life; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen*.



Rev Bryan Dabney of Saint John's Sunday Sermon

We are fortunate to have Bryan's Sunday Sermon. If you want people to come to The

Truth, you have to speak the truth, expouse the truth and live the truth. This is really a good piece and I commend it to your careful reading.

Seventeenth Sunday after Trinity

2 *Timothy* 2:19-26

- 19 Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his. And, let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity.
- 20 But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour.
- 21 If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, and prepared unto every good work.
- 22 Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.
 - 23 But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes.
- 24 And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient,
- ²⁵ In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth;
- ²⁶ And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.

In his letter to Timothy, Paul was promoted by the Holy Ghost to admonish us with these words: Let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity (v. 19b). If

anyone would truly serve the Lord, they must first recognize the evils within themselves and confess those sins to God in the name of his only begotten Son. Only then can true repentance be had. Only then will their works be approved of God.

Now you will not find much support for the above in the modern examples of the Laodicean church. These churches tend to accept any good work as pleasing to God even if it was carried out by one who is not a believer in the Lord Jesus. They are all about showing their tolerance for other faiths instead of presenting the gospel of truth to those lost souls. Our Anglican fathers supplied us with Article XIII of our Articles of Religion which states in part that, "Works done before the grace of Christ, and the inspiration of his Spirit, are not pleasant to God, forasmuch as they spring not of faith in Jesus Christ; neither do they make men meet to receive grace..." If we are to make our works count, then we must first be regenerated—born again in Christ Jesus. Only then will our works be acceptable to God and be counted to us as truly good.

If we do not see ourselves as God sees us apart from godly grace—that is as being vile, filthy, bathed in sin and depravity, despicable, pernicious, an outlaw—then such a person will not see the pressing need to depart from iniquity. They may offer God a momentary recognition of his presence via their occasional good deed, all the while their sins are piling up behind them. It is like the student who believes that one or two good grades will make up for the many substandard grades he or she may have have made during a semester. Yes, they may have scored high here and there, but their real average is something else entirely due to their lack of consistent performance.

True Christians are those who realize that they cannot please God with even the best of their works. God has provided only one way for mankind to achieve a state of justification in his eyes, and it has nothing to do with any work that mortals might do. But it does have everything to do with the atoning sacrifice of our Lord Jesus Christ. His blood covers our sins. His blood makes it possible for us to be accepted into the beloved. If anyone will accept the free gift which God through Jesus Christ offers them, they will be received as children of God and coheirs with Christ in God's kingdom.

St. Paul's warning to noble Timothy stands true. As faithful Christians we ought to entreat and admonish those about us to come to Christ and be saved. If they believe that doing good works is something God wants, then they should know that in order for those works to be pleasing to him, they must follow his prescription for their acceptance. God will have things his way, or else.

Yet the faithless and fraudulent who claim to know Christ will be in for a rude awakening come Judgment Day. Jesus said, Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven (St. Matthew 7:21). And what has God called on us to do? Consider St. John 3:16-21 wherein Jesus said, For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. And this is the condemnation that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

For our deeds to be wrought in God requires that they be first acceptable to God and that will not happen until we are in good standing with him. No matter how you slice it, that is the truth. You cannot pick and choose one Bible truth over another. The devil desires for mankind to live in opposition to the expressed will of God, and then to come before him in hypocrisy knowing full well that he will not accept their feeble offerings if they are not born-again in Christ Jesus. I can only shake my head in disappointment over the Laodicean Church's fruitless efforts to offer God anything it likes while at the same time denying him everything he commands.

Is there any hope for them? Yes, there remains the hope in this life that they will repent. St. Paul finished our epistle lesson with these words, And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, in meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; and that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will (vv. 24-26).

It is my prayer that as God gives you the opening with a person who is as yet in an unregenerated state, that you will exercise godly courage to help them to understand the true nature of themselves and to seek to be made right with God in Christ Jesus our Lord. May it please our good and gracious God today to assist you in this important work.

Let us pray,

FATHER assist us as we carry the message of our risen Lord to those who through the craft and power of the Devil are aliens and strangers to the Christian faith; that by our witness, you would open their hearts to see the need to be made right with you, and that in so doing they will embrace the free gift of grace through Jesus Christ; for it is in his name that we ask these things. Amen.
