



Passion Sunday

Passion Sunday is the fifth Sunday in Lent, and the first Sunday in Passiontide, the last two weeks of Lent, beginning on Passion Sunday and ending on Holy Saturday (the

Saturday before Easter).



All crosses, pictures, images are covered with opaque purple veils and Gloria Patri is often omitted during this period. Passion Sunday is so-called because in the gospel for that day (John 8: 46-59) Jesus begins his sufferings by being stoned out of the temple. Under the old calendar, Passion Sunday was also known as *Judica Sunday*, after that day's Introit: "Judica me, Deus" ("Judge me, O Lord") from Psalm 42 (43), and was called *Black Sunday* in Germany. This alternate name originates from the fact that after Passion Sunday, the Judica Psalm was not said again until Easter; the German title

comes from the old practice of veiling the crosses and statues in the church on that day.

The Roman Catholic Church has completely suppressed Passiontide and eliminated Palm Sunday during the course of abandoning much of the Christian history and doctrine. They now refer to Palm Sunday as "Passion Sunday." Traditional catholics² still observe Passiontide as well as its rites and ceremonies. Passiontide is observed in the Anglican Communion.

The word in English means "including a wide variety of things; all-embracing" in particular as "relating to the historic doctrine and practice of the Western Church." It was first used to describe the Christian Church in the early 2nd century to emphasize its universal scope. In the context of Christian ecclesiology, it has a rich history and several usages. The term has been incorporated into the name of the Roman Catholic Church, arguably not actually a Christian church, though with many Christian members, under the Bishop of Rome. Propers

Each Sunday there are Propers: special prayers and readings from the Bible. There is a Collect for the Day; that is a single thought prayer, most written either before the refounding of the Church of England in the 1540s or written by Bishop Thomas Cranmer, the first Archbishop of Canterbury after the re-founding.

The Collect for the Day is to be read on Sunday and during Morning and Evening Prayer until the next Sunday. The Epistle is normally a reading from one of the various Epistles, or letters, in the New Testament. The Gospel is a reading from one of the Holy Gospels, Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. The Collect is said by the minister as a prayer, the Epistle can be read by either a designated reader (as we do in our church) or by one of the ministers and the Holy Gospel, which during the service in our church is read by an ordained minister.

The propers are the same each year, except if a Red Letter Feast, that is one with propers in the prayerbook, falls on a Sunday, then those propers are to be read instead, except in a White Season, where it is put off. Red Letter Feasts, so called because in the Altar Prayerbooks the titles are in red, are special days. Most of the Red Letter Feasts are dedicated to early saints instrumental in the development of the church, others to special events. Some days are particularly special and the Collect for that day is to be used for an octave (eight days) or an entire season, like Advent or Lent.

The Propers for today are found on Page 132-133, with the Collect first:

The Fifth Sunday in Lent, commonly called Passion Sunday.

WE beseech thee, Almighty God, mercifully to look upon thy people; that by thy great goodness they may be governed and preserved evermore, both in body and soul; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen*.

And due to the rubric, the Collect for the Day is followed by the Collect for Ash Wednesday, which is found on Page 124:

The first day of Lent, commonly called Ash Wednesday.

The Collect.

A LMIGHTY and everlasting God, who hatest nothing that thou hast made, and dost forgive the sins of all those who are penitent; Create and make in us new and contrite hearts, that we, worthily lamenting our sins and acknowledging our wretchedness, may obtain of thee, the God of all mercy, perfect remission and forgiveness; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

¶ This Collect is to be said every day in Lent, after the Collect appointed for the day, until Palm Sunday.

The Epistle for today came from Paul's letter to the Hebrews, the Ninth Chapter, beginning at the Eleventh Verse. Paul summarizes both the symbolism and the substance of the Lord's sacrifice on our behalf. Paul opens the secret of the One Perfect Sacrifice, One Time, for All Time and All Mankind. Paul is clearly appealing to the sense of the Jews when he asks them if the blood of goats will set aside or atone for sin, how much more can be done by the Perfect Sacrifice made on our behalf?

HRIST being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building; neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us. For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh: how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

This morning's Gospel came from the Gospel of Saint John, the Eighth Chapter, beginning at the Forty-Sixth Verse and tells the story of Jesus' confrontation with the Pharisees in the temple. Like much of John it is filled with deep explanation of Jesus and His purpose here.

Knowing them looking to find the worst in Him, Jesus asked, "Which of you convinceth me of sin? And if I say the truth, why do ye not believe me?" In a point central to Christianity, he went on, "He that is of God heareth God's words: ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God." When we hear the term Jews here, we should hear the world in general, for He spoke to all who would not hear. When they would not hear, He pointed out He sought not glory or praise from them, but only from the Father whom in reality they knew not. Here He offers the singular benefit of Christianity, "If a man keep my saying, he shall never see death." This concept being foreign to them, they asked if He thought He was greater than Abraham. That brought the crowning touch, "Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day." Knowing He was only in his early 30s, they could not grasp how he could have seen Abraham.

In a demonstration of the non-linearity of God's time, He said, "Before Abraham was, I am.3" As might be expected, this offended the Keepers of The Law.

Then answered the Jews, and said unto him, Say we not well that thou art a Samaritan, and hast a devil? Jesus answered, I have not a devil; but I honour my Father, and ye do dishonour me. And I seek not mine own glory: there is one that seeketh and judgeth. Verily, verily, I say unto you, If a man keep my saying, he shall never see death. Then said the Jews unto him, Now we know that thou hast a devil. Abraham is dead, and the prophets; and thou sayest, If a man keep my saying, he shall never taste of death. Art thou greater than our father Abraham, which is dead? and the prophets are dead: whom makest thou thyself? The Gospel *John 8:46-59*

TESUS said, Which of you convinceth me of sin? And if I say the truth, why do ye not believe me? 47 He that is of God heareth God's words: ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God. 48 Then answered the Jews, and said unto him, Say we not well that thou art a Samaritan, and hast a devil? 49 Jesus answered, I have not a devil; but I honour my Father, and ye do dishonour me. 50 And I seek not mine own glory: there is one that seeketh and judgeth. 51 Verily, verily, I say unto you, If a man keep my saying, he shall never see death. 52 Then said the Jews unto him, Now we know that thou hast a devil. Abraham is dead, and the prophets; and thou sayest, If a man keep my saying, he shall never taste of death. 53 Art thou greater than our father Abraham, which is dead? and the prophets are dead: whom makest thou thyself? 54 Jesus answered, If I honour myself, my honour is nothing: it is my Father that honoureth me; of whom ye say, that he is your God: 55 Yet ye have not known him; but I know him: and if I should say, I know him not, I shall be a liar like unto you: but I know him, and keep his saying. 56 Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad. 57 Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham? 58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am. 59 Then took they up stones to cast at him: but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.

In this text, Jesus is speaking to the religious leaders of old Israel. The episode ends with these same leaders taking up stones to kill the Son of God. Make no mistake were our Lord to come to the mainline churches of our day in like manner, the response would differ not in the least.

God speaks to His own, and His own hear His Voice. If we are born of God, we shall surely enjoy His counsel and comfort. When God's Word is proclaimed with power and conviction, no argument can stand against it. Since the enemies of God cannot brook the preaching of the Word, and cannot refute it, the weapon of choice is to attack the messenger. Their great problem in attacking Christ is not only the fact that He is the Messenger, but also the Message. How often have we seen their futile attempts to trap Him in His Words redound to their detriment? Even the Church has often struggle with faith. The Church of the modern era no longer struggles with faith – they have lost it! Can it be true that those who believe upon the Lord Jesus Christ shall never see death? If we believe God, we will believe all that He has told us. Every material entity in a material world must fade away and die, but those who are born of the Spirit in Christ have spirits that shall never perish in death or Hell. What is it that makes a man own a reputation of character and strength? It is not his own boasting of himself for reputations are established by more than mere words – it is the testimony of others who know the man and his life that establishes strong reputation and character. Christ did not testify of Himself because His Father in Heaven had already given, and was giving, a Holy Testimony and Revelation of His Son. When we are under God's care and protection, the most violent of criminals cannot lay hands on us without the Father's permit.

46 Which of you convinceth me of sin? And if I say the truth, why do ye not believe me? Has any man present brought charges against Christ? How often did they tempt Him to make a misstep, but He always turned the tables on clerical rascals every bit as greedy in nature and egregious in false teaching as those modern day wonders who populate pulpits across America in our own day. Even when He proved to them their error, they never turned from it. To be honest, they could not turn, for they were of their children the devil.

47 He that is of God heareth God's words: ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God. I never heard the counsel of another father and mother in my own home though it was given in every home in my neighborhood. I heard only the counsel of my own God-given parents. If we are sheep of our Special Shepherd, we may even hear the mumblings of other shepherds with other flocks, but is the Voice of our own shepherd that we hear and follow. It is a fact that wolves will not hear the gentle commands of the Good Shepherd. It is not their intent to hear, but to tear and destroy the sheep. They do not hear and follow because it is not in their nature to hear and follow.

48 Then answered the Jews, and said unto him, Say we not well that thou art a Samaritan, and hast a devil? Since Christ has truly identified these culprits as not true members of the family of God, they return to their old, trite argument of bloodlines. They call Christ a Samaritan (which they do not consider members of Israel). Suddenly, just by merely speaking words of reason and logic – and doing or saying nothing vile – Christ is labelled as having a devil! Need I remind you that rulers of the Jews have committed blasphemy and, this, not the first time?

49 Jesus answered, I have not a devil; but I honour my Father, and ye do dishonour me. Christ has accused these men of nothing that is not an absolute of the Holy Scriptures. Since Christ honors the Word of God the Father, and these men do not,

which of the two have a devil? The Pharisees and Jews refuted, in custom, tradition, and action, the Word of God. They dishonor God thereby and even so His Son.

50 <u>And I seek not mine own glory: there is one that seeketh and judgeth</u>. Christ came to redeem and not to judge. The judgment has already been made by God's Holy Word. It is by the standard of that Word that men are judged. If we are IN Christ, we are not under the terms of the Law and condemnation. But these men were far from the gates of the Holy City of God. Their deeds would judge them by that perfect standard of the Law. If we judge sin around us by God's Law, and not our own opinion, then it is that Law of God that judges and not us.

51 <u>Verily, Verily, I say unto you, If a man keep my saying, he shall never see death.</u> This solution is too simple – too plain bread – for the sophisticated oracles of Judaism. How short a stride from hate and condemnation to freedom and liberty in Christ, but East is East and West is West and never the twain shall meet:

Oh, East is East, and West is West, and never the twain shall meet, Till Earth and Sky stand presently at God's great Judgment Seat. Rudyard Kipling (1865-1936)

"In Christ all shall be made alive; but that the depth and extent of the Scriptural term life can never be limited to the mere revival of the soul from death or unconsciousness seems obvious on the most cursory inspection of the sacred volume. So far is mere immortality from answering to this gift of life, that there is a species of immortality to which the title of death, "eternal death," and the "second death" is given. It appears hence that this life, as well as the death spoken of in the text, is essentially a moral, not a merely physical, state or notion; that it is a blessed and spiritual vitality. To express His highest spiritual bestowments no term is more frequently employed by our blessed Lord than "light." Now, this light is itself perpetually connected with His descriptions or intimations of the life He was to bestow. *My followers shall have the 'light of life*, He declares to the Pharisees; while the shadow of death is, as you know, the constant type of a state of hopeless spiritual ruin to those who do not know Christ and understand that shadow to have no power over them."

Then said the Jews unto him, Now we know that thou hast a devil. Abraham is dead, and the prophets; and thou sayest, If a man keep my saying, he shall never taste of death. They are actually accusing Jesus of denying that Abraham followed God. They know that there is a grave in Machpelah that contains the bones of Abraham. Their dim wits, lighted by darkness only, cannot comprehend (or refuse to) the words of Christ. All they know and understand is the "here and now". An eternal Heaven escapes their imagination. They may make allusions to that Heaven, just as false professor of our own time do, but they do not believe that any "sophisticated and educated" marvel could ever seriously believe it - just like most modern false teachers.

53 Art thou greater than our father Abraham, which is dead? and the prophets are <u>dead: whom makest thou thyself</u>? They know DEATH, but they do not know LIFE! Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Life. Their scale-covered eyes do not see because

they have dwelt in darkness so very long that they are blinded to Light.

54 Jesus answered, If I honour myself, my honour is nothing: it is my Father that honoureth me; of whom ye say, that he is your God: How can men know intimately a great King and not recognize His sons and daughters? It is actually impossible. The King sends His Son to greet those who claim His sovereignty. He forewarns them of His son's Coming. He has written to them of it, spoken of it to them by the prophets whom they killed, and now the genuine Article stands before them and they know it not – or DO they?

55 Yet ye have not known him; but I know him: and if I should say, I know him not, I shall be a liar like unto you: but I know him, and keep his saying. It is likely that the Jews have a head knowledge of God, but they have changed His character and description from that which He claims to be, to one which suits their own passions. When we know God of a truth we cannot disavow His sayings as the Chart and Compass of our lives.

often we fail to remember that Abraham was a Christian like unto the true Christian of this day. His view of Christ was ALL of faith. He looked forward, in faith, to the Coming Redeemer in Christ. He was preached the Gospel and he believed the Gospel. Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness. Know ye therefore that they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham. And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, In thee shall all nations be blessed. (Gal 3:6-8) It was not the Stones of Sinai, or of Moses, that saves, but the Grace of God in Christ Jesus.

Abraham rejoiced to see the day of Christ. He had a glimpse of that day of the birth of Jesus Christ, born of the Virgin Mary, as He had a glimpse also of the manner in which Jesus Christ should work out our redemption. He took his son Isaac and offered him up on Mount Moriah—that Isaac so exceedingly dear, of whom it was said, that "in Isaac shall thy seed be called." He offered him up, his one hope of becoming the father of many nations. And that act of Abraham—that act of faith, was counted unto him for righteousness; and he is held up for ever as the father of the faithful. To him, as St. Paul writes, "The Scripture foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the Gospel, saying, In thee shall all nations be blessed."

Jesus Christ Himself lived before Abraham was born. Whenever God is spoken of as holding communion and as being visible to man, it is in the Second Person of the Holy Trinity, God, the Son, Jesus Christ. It is He who declares to us the Father. It is He who represents God to us, and is Himself God, even Jesus Christ. This was He who talked with and was called the friend of Abraham. It was He who was the Giver of the Law to Moses, it is He by whose agency the worlds were made, God the Supreme Deity dwelleth in the light which no man can approach: but Jesus Christ who is the image of the Invisible God, hath manifested, made known, declared to us, what God is; how good, how gracious, how ready to forgive, and how rich in mercy to those who call upon Him. It follows, then, that we should honour and worship Him as God, we should draw near with all reverence, with all holiness, with bowed heads and bowed hearts, to present our supplication before Him.

57 Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham? God is the God of the living and not the dead. Of course, Jesus has seen Abraham. As a matter of fact, grasp this: He saw Abraham before Abraham saw

himself.

58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am. Yes, He was before Abraham, He was before Adam, He was before the worlds (which He made) were cast into orbit by the artful Finger of God. He was before Gabriel and all created angels. Don't we recall that He was before the beginning of all things? There was never a time when Christ was not in the Eternal Presence – I AM!

59 Then took they up stones to cast at him: but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by. Ah, yes, the Ancien' Regime! Destroy all opposition – if not by words, then, by all means, with stones. Though truth may lie trampled beneath the iron heel of hate, it cannot be destroyed. Like the Spirit Itself, Truth shall arise time and again after the futile attempts of the ungodly to silence it. But, alas, it was not the appointed time of Christ to offer Himself. Though they would have stoned Him, He wonderfully passed through them, out of the Temple, under cover of Light. So may we all be protected from the wiles of the devil!

It is a great comfort to realize that our Lord is Eternally Present with His people, and He passes by unobserved by those who reject Him.

Sermon - Rev Jack ArnoldChurch of the Faithful Centurion - Descanso, California

Today's sermon brought the Collect, Epistle and Gospel together and is partly contained in the forewords above.

Consider these words from the Collect:

... thy people; ... by thy great goodness ... may be governed and preserved evermore, both in body and soul ...

In the Collect, we ask God to help us to look to Him for leadership and direction that we might be saved, both our physical bodies and souls. For, if we do not look to God for our guidance and direction we are surely lost like a man in the wilderness without a compass. When we ask that we might be governed and thus preserved by His *great goodness*, we are in effect asking for His Guidance for us to be guided. Guided, that means we need to ask, then listen

to what He Tells us, then actually follow that guidance. Recall to mind this quote from GK Chesterton:

 "Christianity has not been tried and found wanting; it has been found difficult and not tried."

It does absolutely no good for us to ask God for guidance, then when He gives it to us for us to ignore or pretend we did not hear. After all, there are none so deaf as those who will not hear, a concept discussed more fully in Matthew 13.13. Thus, we need to ask for He Help, His Guidance, then actually do our very best to follow Him.

If we look to Him for guidance, we then look to Him for safety. Safety means <u>only</u> the safety of our soul, our eternal life. Things may get tense here, for as Aslan is not a tame lion, God is not a tame god. He is the one true and triune God. Not tame, but the savior of mankind. Think about this; pretty clearly the Mosaic Law with its 613 rules

did not really work to save mankind. The constant sacrifice of animals could not make us accounted for as perfect in God's eye. After all, an animal would never work to cleanse our sins, account us as perfect and let us enter into heaven, as Christ's sacrifice by the terrible death on the Cross did for us. An animal is a poor substitute for a divine being that is our conduit from heaven to earth, and visa versa. Yet this was only an intermediate step towards Christ as we will hear about more in a minute.. The law to paraphrase the words of St. Paul was our teacher to make us ready for the coming of Christ. Without having had the law as our base, we would not have been ready for Christ. It was a needed step to prepare the world for Jesus. We were always destined to fail. We cannot make the grade on our own. We need the One Sacrifice, One Time, for all mankind, for all time.

Our only means of being accounted as perfect when we come before God is to rely on the sacrifice and intermediary priesthood of His Son, our Savior Jesus Christ to account us as perfect before God on that final day. Your AOC ministers, while officially titled as priests are not intermediary priests, there is one high priest, Jesus Christ the Righteous who is also the propitiation for our sins! He is our Savior, our Leader, our Teacher, our Master, our Example!

Christ came to succeed the Old Covenant which was marked by sacrifices of innocent animals, that really did not do the job, with the New Covenant which is marked by His death on the cross for our sins, and this has done the job which was intended. Before the world began God knew of both the New and the Old Covenants. The Old Covenant had to be put in place before the New Covenant or Jesus could come to Earth. The people had to be prepared for Him.

At the same time, as imperfect creatures with free will if we do our very best to follow His Word, we will not be perfect. On the other hand, we will be better than we will if we do not. Thus, without the sacrifice of His Son, we will not make the cut. It is a better solution than sacrificing the animals like the Hebrews. Without Him, we will end up in the pit. We need that one sacrifice, one time, for all mankind, for all time. If we did not need that sacrifice, then we wouldn't be seeing all the troubles in the world today. Today's world makes clear the need for the sacrifice He made for us; one time for all time. Unlike the sacrifices of the Old Testament, which required multiple sacrifices a year, this sacrifice was made one time, one year, for all time. It is a far superior arrangement, but it came at a heavier cost than the Old Covenant, the cost of His death. It is a cost that we should always remember and be thankful that He was willing to die for our sins.

In the Gospel, Jesus reminds us that if we believe in Him and keep His Word (keeping His Word meaning acting upon it), then we shall make our seamless journey from the Shadowlands to His Home. Few of the Pharisees could conceive, or peradventure would not conceive, that God would send His Son to this world for us. They did not even believe He had a son, they were looking for the Messiah figure they thought couldn't be Him. The Messiah was in fact Jesus, the Christ of God. They expected an earthly savior, one who would drive the Romans out and put the Jews in charge of that corner of the world. They did not expect a divine savior and could not conceive that this savior would come from God, as His Own Son, to offer himself up as a sacrifice in our stead.

Their problem was that Jesus came to save our souls and give us eternal life, eternal life starting right then. Not just for the Jews and Israel, but the whole wide world, Jew, Gentile, Greek and all others. Jesus brought salvation and life to the entire world. That

was not what the Pharisees were looking so hard for with their magnifying glasses as they examined Torah and The Law. Pharisees were not big picture people, and as Calvin told Hobbes, "We big picture people rarely become historians." It would seem that also applied to the Pharisees though they were not "big picture people", they misinterpreted the prophecies of the Messiah. Regardless, even though some people chose to misunderstand the prophecies, He came and He made that one sacrifice, at one time, for all mankind, for all time. For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life⁴.

Who is Jesus? Our Savior? Indeed. But, more He has been since before the beginning of the world, for He is one with I Am.

Through His Actions, we are saved.

Bishop Dennis Campbell's Sermon

Bishop Dennis is a brilliant speaker. He is able to take biblical precepts and make them

perfectly understandable, even to me. Oft he provides the text of his sermons and I take the utmost pleasure in passing them on:



Passion Sunday Hebrews 9:12 March 13, 2016

We have only fourteen days left until Easter. That means Lent is drawing to a close. I hope you have been devoting yourself to growing in holiness during this

time. I hope you always, continuously, and habitually devote yourself to holiness, but I also hope you have been making it a special emphasis in your life during Lent. If you haven't, I urge and encourage you to do so during these next fourteen days. We live in a time when people are confused about what it means to be a Christian. The popular view is that it means to have happy religious experiences, which enable you to overcome obstacles in life, and live in perpetual happiness, health, and prosperity. But happiness, as these people define it, is not the essence of being a Christian. Holiness is. Yet, somehow, in the contemporary emphasis on feelings and experiences, and miracles and prosperity, holiness seems to be overlooked. May it not be so among us. May it not be so in your life.

I know people will tell you ecstatic experiences and miracles are proof that the Holy Spirit dwells in you. But, according to the Bible, holiness is the proof. It is not ecstatic experiences or feelings that show His presence, it is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith meekness, temperance; the fruit of the Spirit, as we read in Galatians 5:22. "But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye

have your fruit unto holiness" says Romans 6:22. This is the proof that the Holy Spirit dwells in you.

The closing days of Lent are sometimes called Passion season, because during this time we begin to emphasise the Passion, or, suffering, of Christ on the cross. Our reading in the book of Hebrews is part of this emphasis. Hebrews contains words like, "by His own blood," "the blood of Christ," and "by means of death, for the redemption of transgressions." These words refer to Christ's suffering and death. They explain why He suffered, and why He died on that cross, when He could have easily come down from it and, in a single word, destroyed the whole world and cast all of its people into hell.

The Bible uses many words to describe the atonement of sins accomplished by Christ on the cross. One word stuck with me last week as I pondered this passage in preparation for this sermon. That word is, "once." It occurs in verse 12, which tells us Christ, "entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us." Another verse, which is not part of what we read this morning, but is part of the same book and chapter, says, "So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many."

Once is such a small word, yet it carries such immense meaning. Think of the phrase, "once in a life time." It means an event or opportunity happens once, and never happens again. In all of eternity, it only comes once. And when it is gone, it is gone forever. In reference to Christ's death, and the atonement and redemption He purchased for His people, once means it only happened one time in all eternity. There is no repetition of it. Its one time is its first, last, and only time.

"Once" also conveys the idea of completion. It only needs to be done once, because the salvation and redemption accomplished by it is full and complete. It does not need to be repeated because it accomplished everything it needed to accomplish in one event. Once is sufficient.

Hebrews 9 contrasts the one sacrifice of Christ with the repetitive sacrifices made by the priests and people in the Old Testament era. There seemed to be no end of the myriad sacrifices required by the Old Testament law. The highest and most holy of all the sacrifices was offered on the Day of Atonement. Yet, even it was not sufficient to make an eternal atonement for sin. It was offered every year, for centuries and centuries. Only the sacrifice of God's own Son, the Lamb of God, could accomplish complete and eternal atonement for sin. And because Christ is the Son of God, God in the flesh, the Lamb of God, who willingly died as the substitute and representative of sinners, He can and does accomplish full and eternal salvation for us, by His one offering of Himself.

The word, "once" occurs several times in the New Testament. One I think is particularly relevant to the point of Hebrews 9:12 is found in Jude 3, "earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints." As most of you know, the New Testament was originally written in Greek. And the same Greek word appears in both Hebrews 9:12 and Jude 3. In both verses, it is correctly translated, "once," in the King James Version. In Jude it refers to what we might call, the Christian faith. It encompasses all the doctrines and practices given by God and preserved in the Bible. In the Bible, that faith is, "delivered unto the saints." It is delivered to the people of God. It is given to us. "Once" means that faith is given once for all time. It is delivered in its fullness. It is complete. It never needs to be updated. It never needs to be supplemented. There will never be another testimony of Jesus Christ. It never needs to be changed to fit a new generation, or a new person, or a new world. It is the same forever. It is delivered once to all people and for all time.

In the same way, the death of Christ happened once for all time. He does not need to die again. He does not need to be offered on another cross. He is not re-sacrificed on a table in a church by a man on Sunday mornings. He died once for all. He was, "once offered to bear the sins of many."

So the question for us, today is not, does Christ need to be re-sacrificed for us, or, is His one sacrifice sufficient to atone for our sins? The question for us is, have we, have you, trusted in His sacrifice as the full and complete atonement for your sins?

And due to the rubric, the Collect for the Day is followed by the Collect for Ash Wednesday, which is found on Page 124:



A LMIGHTY and everlasting God, who hatest nothing that thou hast made, and dost forgive the sins of all those who are penitent; Create and make in us new and contrite hearts, that we, worthily lamenting our sins and acknowledging our



wretchedness, may obtain of thee, the God of all mercy, perfect remission and forgiveness; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

¶ This Collect is to be said every day in Lent, after the Collect appointed for the day, until Palm Sunday.

What an amazing set of scripture for this Passion Sunday. We have in the verses from the ninth chapter of Hebrews a certification of Christ:

- 1. He is a high priest of good things to come;
- 2. He is greater and more perfect than the tabernacle;
- 3. By his blood shed once in the holy place (ie. the temple) he obtains eternal redemption for us. The perfect sacrifice by way of the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot {sin} to purge our conscience from dead works to serve the living God;
- 4. And the greatest of all he {Christ} is the mediator of the new testament, by his death, for the redemption of [all] the transgressions that were [made] under the first testament [because of Adam's fall], that all who are, were and will be called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

Now mind you this is the certification we find in the Book of Hebrews. Christ Jesus is certified to the Jews, showing that he was the once and for all sacrifice that had been foreshadowed all throughout the Old Testament. The Book of Hebrews outlines the culmination of the life of Christ as the fulfillment of the Promise made to Abraham by God the Father. That promise being that all the world would have the opportunity of salvation by means of the One who would come through the Hebrew people, his name was Emanuel. *God with us*.

All of us who are called will receive eternal inheritance, in other words, Salvation. Eternal Salvation.

In our passage from the eighth chapter of the gospel of John we learn of the certification of Jesus from his own words.

In Jesus three and a half year ministry, the time that he was revealed to the children of Israel and a select few Gentiles, he would face much opposition from those who thought they knew better. This battle for the hearts and minds of the people would become more and more heated as the day of Christ death got closer. We can see that Satan is trying to prevent Jesus from dying on the Cross, because Satan knew once that had happened, all the prophecies that pertained to this Day would be fulfilled. And most importantly, Satan knew that his time was now certainly short. He was defeated. Yes he would continue to this day to fight a losing battle, but he knows with great certainty, that he will be totally defeated when Christ comes again to claim his Bride, the Church, the very people whom he died for so many years ago. Yes he died, but he also rose again in a glorious resurrection, defeating death and Satan.

Jesus very clearly delineates the difference between believers and non-believers. 'You do not hear the words of God...because you are not of God.'

As the sceptics continued to bait Christ he kept answering them with Spiritual concepts. 'Verily, verily, I say unto you, if a man keep my saying, he shall never see death.'

These 'learned' Jews immediately jump on that saying, not realizing that Christ was

speaking of spiritual death. They just don't get it, they are blind to the truth that Jesus is sharing with them.

So then Jesus answers by saying that if he honored himself it would be nothing, it is my Father that honors me, (the very God you say is yours). But you don't know him, (now the kicker) 'but I know him'. 'if I should say I know him not, I would be like you all, ...a liar. But I do know him.

In fact your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day (this time period of Christ's earthly ministry). [Abraham] saw it and was glad. The learned Jews then challenged Jesus to the fact that he wasn't even fifty years old, 'how could he have seen Abraham?'

Now the coup de grace, '...Jesus said unto them, *Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.*' To any Jew who had a basic knowledge of the Hebrew scripture, this pronouncement, I AM, was what God told Moses, it is what God told Abraham, it was what God told many of his prophets. I AM was the Creator God telling his creations he is Eternal. I AM is, was and is to come....in other words always, Eternally now.

So of course the Jews picked up stones to kill Jesus. He just told them he was God. This was blasphemy. These so called wise ones had read the word but did not understand the word. They were familiar with the words of the Hebrew testament, but did not understand what Jesus was saying. They did not understand that Jesus was revealing at the time, that he and God the Father, were the same.

Let us not just read the Word of God, let us take the Word of God to heart. Let us read, digest and inwardly absorb the Word so it becomes the very fiber of our Spiritual existence, that the Word becomes our very life.

Let us pray:

Aunto the world's end; We give thee humble thanks for opening heathen lands to the light of thy truth; for making paths in the deep waters and highways in the desert; and for planting thy Church in all the earth. Grant, we beseech thee, unto us thy servants, that with lively faith we may labor abundantly to make known to all men thy blessed gift of eternal life; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen*.

ORD our heavenly Father, whose blessed Son came not to be ministered unto, but to minister; We beseech thee to bless all who, following in his steps, give themselves to the service of their fellow men. Endue them with wisdom, patience, and courage, that they may strengthen the weak and raise up those who fall; and, being inspired by thy love, may worthily minister in thy Name to the suffering, the friendless, and the needy; for the sake of him who laid down his life for us, the same thy Son, our Savior, Jesus Christ. *Amen*.

DIRECT us, O Lord, in all our doings, with thy most gracious favour, and further us with thy continual help; that in all our works begun, continued, and ended in thee, we may glorify thy holy Name, and finally, by thy mercy, obtain everlasting life; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen*.

We are fortunate to have Bryan's Sunday Sermon. If you want people to come to The Truth, you have to speak the truth, expouse the truth and live the truth. This is really a good piece and I commend it to your

careful reading.

Fifth Sunday in Lent

In today's epistle, the apostle Paul spoke of our need for a mediator when he wrote, For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh: how much more shall the blood of Christ, who



through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance (Hebrews 9:13- 15). The apostle also noted that the law was ordained by angels in the hand of a mediator (Galatians 3:16-22) and truly Christ is our mediator: who came to serve as our link to God the Father.

And so from the moment we accepted his atoning sacrifice, our names were inscribed within the Book of Life. Our Lord came into this world to serve as our mediator— our intercessor— standing at our side much as any attorney might do for us in court. While he is our advocate, he also serves us in ways different from an earthly attorney. He is able to answer every charge brought against us by saying, "No Charge." And this he has the power to do because from the moment we accepted his gift of grace, we received an immediate and binding pardon which renders every accusation against us void as he cancelled them at the cross.

Now, there are those with the church who have accepted the false doctrine of inclusion without faith in Jesus Christ. They may profess a "belief" in our Lord without an acceptance of his divine nature and that he truly rose again that first Easter morning. Folks, there is a big difference between a mere belief in the existence of Jesus Christ and acceptance of his person as the Saviour⁶. No doubt you have heard people express a belief in Jesus Christ, but what do they mean?

Well, it all depends on what they believe to true about our Lord. I can hold a belief that Zeus was one of the gods of the ancient world without accepting his actual divinity. In other words, I am simply acknowledging the historical record that the Greeks worshipped a being whom they believed to be the "king of the gods of Olympus" known as Zeus and nothing more. In a similar vein, many people today believe that

⁶ This is the Trilemma of Jack Lewis in Mere Christianity - I am trying here to prevent anyone saying the really foolish thing that people often say about Him: I'm ready to accept Jesus as a great moral teacher, but I don't accept his claim to be God. That is the one thing we must not say. A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher. He would either be a lunatic — on the level with the man who says he is a poached egg — or else he would be the Devil of Hell. You must make your choice. Either this man was, and is, the Son of God, or else a madman or something worse. You can shut him up for a fool, you can spit at him and kill him as a demon or you can fall at his feet and call him Lord and God, but let us not come with any patronizing nonsense about his being a great human teacher. He has not left that open to us. He did not intend to.

Jesus of Nazareth was an actual person while rejecting him as being God's only begotten Son.

So the lesson here is that we must not only believe in the reality of our Lord as a man who walked this earth some two millennia ago; we must also accept his atoning work on the cross, his death, resurrection and ascension, as well as his promise to come again in glory as our Judge and King.

Many churches today are peddling what is termed as an "easy believism." To them, one need only express a belief in Jesus Christ without teaching them the fundamentals of what it truly means to accept him as Saviour and Lord. Without a solid grounding in God's word written, what sort of beliefs will they entertain about him? Do they believe he was just a "good" man, or a gifted public speaker or a sage offering philosophical advice? It might surprise you to learn the unregenerate of our Lord's day regarded him as merely a good teacher and a healer which is little different from what today's mass man believes. And just like those of the unregenerate who joined the early church, they may fall under the influence of the many and varied cults of Christ. For if one does not have a proper Bible understanding of our Lord, such persons will be, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive (Ephesians 4:14).

Ergo, without a Spirit-inspired belief in our Lord, the unregenerated will not recognize him as their "Mediator and Advocate" which will render them unfit to receive God's love and blessings. It matters not that they were baptized, or even made a public profession of faith by saying a "sinner's prayer." If their belief in Christ does not change them effectually, they will live as if Christ had never lived, and they will die without his grace to lift them heavenward because they did not truly accept him into their hearts, but merely uttered with their lips his holy name. Whether you realize this or not, that sort of behavior— falsely claiming to be in Christ while denying him as the Saviour— is a violation of the commandment, Thou shall not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain.

I have often wondered why so many who have been exposed to the gospel reject it. The gospel of our Lord provides true peace in these evil days. It contains that greater love which no mortal can express or imagine. It speaks of God's forgiveness for our faults and failings as well as their expungement when we confess them to the Father in Christ's name. Through our faith we are thus redeemed from death, hell and the grave. The gospel of our Lord comforts us with the blessed assurance of God's everlasting promise. And as we believe him to be the Messiah, we believe also that he has gone into heaven to prepare a place for us so that in due time he will come again to bring us home. We believe that as saved persons, he will empower our spiritual gifts so that we might expand the number of the elect through our witness.

There is so much good that the Godhead is willing to make manifest to all people, and yet many persist in discounting the gospel message either at its initial presentation, or after having briefly experienced its effects. They tend to keep God at arms length because of their lack of faith, and are thus lured away by temptations of this life.

Thankfully, we who have been born again possess God's gift of grace. Every time we recite the words of either the Apostles' Creed or the Nicene Creed, we are affirming our belief that Jesus Christ is our only Mediator and Advocate and that through our confession to the Father in his name, we are forgiven, cleansed and made whole in his sight. Only afterward, are we able to approach God's throne of grace where we may lay

before him our cares and concerns, our praises and thanksgivings knowing that they will be heard by the Father.

If you have not done so, I encourage you to come and receive Jesus Christ. Seek his will for you. Read and inwardly digest his word and commandment. Honor him as your Saviour, Redeemer and Friend, your great high priest, and the author and finisher of your faith. Do not reject his teachings because you do not fully understand them, or reduce God's word written to human terms and thus allegorize away the miraculous and the prophetic. God's word is true. It is inspired and inerrant. It contains much which can help you in this life, and it will also prepare you for the life to come. It clearly sets forth for all to see that a loving God stepped into his creation to redeem that which was lost. Make it your prayer today that God will touch your heart, and that you would embrace his only begotten Son as your only Mediator and Advocate.

Let us pray,

Hand service so that others might come to know Jesus Christ as their Saviour and Lord; for this we ask in his most holy name. *Amen*.
