Propers

Each Sunday there are Propers: special prayers and readings from the Bible. There is a Collect for the Day; that is a single thought prayer, most written either before the refounding of the Church of England in the 1540s or written by Bishop Thomas Cranmer, the first Archbishop of Canterbury after the re-founding.

The Collect for the Day is to be read on Sunday and during Morning and Evening Prayer until the next Sunday. The Epistle is normally a reading from one of the various Epistles, or letters, in the New Testament. The Gospel is a reading from one of the Holy Gospels, Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. The Collect is said by the minister as a prayer, the Epistle can be read by either a designated reader (as we do in our church) or by one of the ministers and the Holy Gospel, which during the service in our church is read by an ordained minister.

The propers are the same each year, except if a Red Letter Feast, that is one with propers in the prayerbook, falls on a Sunday, then those propers are to be read instead, except in a White Season, where it is put off. Red Letter Feasts, so called because in the Altar Prayerbooks the titles are in red, are special days. Most of the Red Letter Feasts are dedicated to early saints instrumental in the development of the church, others to special events. Some days are particularly special and the Collect for that day is to be used for an octave (eight days) or an entire season, like Advent or Lent.

The Propers for today are found on Page 173-174, with the Collect first:

The Third Sunday after Easter. *The Collect.*

LMIGHTY God, who showest to them that are in error the light of thy truth, to the intent that they may return into the way of righteousness; Grant unto all those who are admitted into the fellowship of Christ's Religion, that they may avoid those things that are contrary to their profession, and follow all such things as are agreeable to the same; through our Lord Jesus Christ. *Amen.*

The Epistle for today came from the Second Chapter of the First Epistle of Saint Peter beginning at the Eleventh Verse. Peter tells us to live a good life, to follow the directions Jesus left us, to make ourselves positive examples of citizen to others, to be leaders of our community, drawing people towards God. To live out the life Jesus commanded, to do nothing to draw ill repute on the Word of God. To be truly free and follow freedom to where God wants us to be, not to Donkey Island, where false freedom takes so many.

EARLY beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul; having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation. Submit yourselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake: whether it be to the king, as supreme; or unto governors, as unto them that are sent by him for the punishment of evildoers, and for the praise of them that do well. For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men: as free, and not using your liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God. Honour all men. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king.

Today's Gospel came from the Sixteenth Chapter of the Gospel according to Saint John beginning at the Sixteenth Verse.

Jesus warns his disciples of the events about to unfold. He is to be taken from them shortly by the painful death on the Cross for our redemption. He will not be with them here on earth. Yet, after three days time He will Rise from death, having overcome death for us. When He is gone from us we are sorrowful, just like the disciples. He came back from death for us. And yet He was to leave again, yet not be gone from us as the Father would send the Holy Ghost to make His abode in our hearts and bring Jesus to us.

ESUS said to his disciples, A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me, because I go to the Father. Then said some of his disciples among themselves, What is this that he saith unto us, A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me: and, Because I go to the Father? They

said therefore, What is this that he saith, A little while? we cannot tell what he saith. Now Jesus knew that they were desirous to ask him, and said unto them, Do ye enquire among yourselves of that I said, A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me? Verily, verily, I say unto you, That ye shall weep and lament, but the world shall rejoice: and ye shall be sorrowful, but your sorrow shall be turned into joy. A woman when she is in travail hath sorrow, because her hour is come: but as soon as she is delivered of the child, she remembereth no more the anguish, for joy that a man is born into the world. And ye now therefore have sorrow: but I will see you again, and your heart shall rejoice, and your joy no man taketh from you.


Bishop Ogles' Sermon

We are oft fortunate to get copies of Bishop Jerry's sermon notes. Today is one of those Sundays. Today's sermon starts off with the collect, and like always,

it will give you a lot to consider in your heart.

Sermon Notes

Third Sunday after Easter St Andrew's Anglican Orthodox Church 7 May 2016, Anno Domini (In the Year of our Lord)





O beloved. 2 I sleep, but my heart waketh: it is the voice of my beloved that knocketh, saying, Open to me, my sister, my love, my dove, my undefiled: for my head is filled with dew, and my locks with the drops of the night. 3 I have put off my coat; how shall I put it on? I have washed my feet; how shall I defile them? 4 My beloved put in his hand by the hole of the door, and my bowels were moved for him. 5 I rose up to open to my beloved; and my hands dropped with myrrh, and my fingers with sweet smelling myrrh, upon the handles of the lock. 6 I opened to my beloved; but my beloved had withdrawn himself, and was gone: my soul failed when he spake: I sought him, but I could not find him; I called him, but he gave me no answer... 14 His hands are as gold rings set with the beryl: his belly is as bright ivory overlaid with sapphires. 15 His legs are as pillars of marble, set upon sockets of fine gold: his countenance is as Lebanon, excellent as the cedars. 16 His mouth is most sweet: yea, he is altogether lovely. This is my beloved, and this is my friend, O daughters of Jerusalem. (Song 5:1-6, 14-16)

The Song of Solomon is a beautiful story of Christ and His Church. It is written in metaphor and parable. It reveals the intimacy of expression and deep love which Christ has for His Church and which His Church should have for Him.

<u>I am come into my garden, my sister, my spouse</u>: Sadly, we often doubt the presence of Christ with us. He loves His Bride so much, and us individually, that He cannot let us out of His sight. How can we allow His presence to go without acknowledgement. Is it possible, when we need Him most, He is right beside us as He was to Mary Magdalene at the Tomb, the two travelers on the Road to Emmaus, and the fearful disciples aboard the ship on the stormy Galilean Sea? So, He must announce He has come to us! In fact, He often stands at the door and knocks while we remain oblivious to His coming. In speaking to the churches of Revelations, He says, *I stand at the door and knock*. (Rev 3:20). Unfortunately, that places Him OUTSIDE – not INSIDE – the greater number of churches.

<u>I have gathered my myrrh with my spice; I have eaten my honeycomb with my honey; I have drunk my wine with my milk: eat, O friends; drink, yea, drink abundantly, O beloved</u>. He has done all required for the dowry of His Bride. He has received the myrrh of the burial and the sweet spices of His resurrection. Because He has drunk His wine

(Cup of Suffering) with His milk (Morning Joy), He insist the entitlement for us to do so as well, for all that is His is all of His Bride's, too. We are 'beloved' to Him. What a special title we have from such an exalted Lord and King.

<u>I sleep, but my heart waketh: it is the voice of my beloved that knocketh, saying, Open</u> to me, my sister, my love, my dove, my undefiled: for my head is filled with dew, and my <u>locks with the drops of the night</u>. The Bride is not so watchful as the Groom. She sleeps while He has suffered the dews of the night. But she does, indeed, hear His Voice and knows the Voice. And the Bride is not only a Bride, but a Sister as well. My mother and my brethren are these which hear the word of God, and do it. (Luke 8:21)

<u>I have put off my coat; how shall I put it on? I have washed my feet; how shall I defile</u> <u>them</u>? What deplorable excuses the Church makes to cover its unwillingness to bear the cross. It is not convenient! It is not the proper time! I have been sleeping and need rest to regain my bearings? Today's church is quick to act on matters involving power and pelf, yet slow to do those things necessary to nurture wisdom and knowledge of God in her members. It is a small thing to build a two million dollar Taj Mahal, but quite a burden to put one's self out to bring the sheaf to the barn.

<u>My beloved put in his hand by the hole of the door, and my bowels were moved for him</u>. He will use His charms and His Spirit to beckon and to lure us and, yet, we still are slow to respond. If we are too slow, He will not linger at the door always. The term 'bowels' here is used in the same manner the term 'heart' is used today. Our hearts are moved for Him because His heart was first moved for us. *We love him, because he first loved us*. (1 John 4:19).

<u>I rose up to open to my beloved; and my hands dropped with myrrh, and my</u> <u>fingers with sweet smelling myrrh, upon the handles of the lock</u>. Too slowly does the church arise to open its door to Christ, and too often is Christ OUTSIDE the Church and not INSIDE. (Rev 3:20). Her hands are full of the myrrh of repentance, but the lock of the door is the sin that has kept Him out.

<u>I opened to my beloved; but my beloved had withdrawn himself, and was gone: my soul</u> <u>failed when he spake: I sought him, but I could not find him; I called him, but he gave me</u> <u>no answer</u>. The Spaniards have a beautiful name and title for Christ: Jesus es el Senor! or 'Jesus is a Gentleman'. And so He is. He does not intrude where He is not welcome. We may avoid Christ to the point that He will not answer without prevailing prayer. She awoke from sleep when He called, else He would have departed for ever. Now she must be chastened for her reluctance to watch and wait.

<u>His hands are as gold rings set with the beryl: his belly is as bright ivory</u> <u>overlaid with sapphires. His legs are as pillars of marble, set upon sockets of fine gold:</u> <u>his countenance is as Lebanon, excellent as the cedars</u>. The precious stones mentioned are those stones of the foundation for New Jerusalem. (Rev 21:19,20). The gold rings are symbols of authority. His is tall and majestic as the Cedars of Lebanon.

His mouth is most sweet: yea, he is altogether lovely. This is my beloved, and this is my friend, O daughters of Jerusalem. From His mouth we have heard only kindness and loveliness. He is my Friend that sticketh closer than a brother. (Pro 18:24). He is the only One for the Church for there can be no other. She LOVES Him, and so must we

Perhaps we should stop to consider well what a marvelously wonderful Savior we have. He is madly in love with His Bride, the True Church. Should that love go unrequited by those who are showered with love without merit?

Sermon – Reverend Jack Arnold - Time and Action Church of the Faithful Centurion Descanso, California

Today's sermon brought the Collect, Epistle and Gospel together and is partly contained in the forewords above.



We are in the Easter Season which consists of Easter and the following four Sundays, until we get to Rogation Sunday. This is a time we should work on centering our lives on the central figure in our religion, Jesus Christ.

Consider these words from the Collect:

... who showest to them that are in error the light of thy truth, to the intent that they may return into the way of righteousness; Grant unto all those who are admitted into the

fellowship of Christ's Religion, that they may avoid those things that are contrary to their profession, and follow all such things as are agreeable to the same...

God is a Triune God; Father, Son, Holy Ghost. The function of the Holy Ghost is to open our souls, hearts and minds to God's Will. It is to help us not be so deaf as those who will not hear. Thus, to open our "ears" to His Voice. As is oft the case, the Collect really asks us to let the Holy Ghost in so He can change us. Today's Sunday Report has a quote from Jack Lewis out of Mere Christianity:

"When He said, 'Be perfect,' He meant it. He meant that we must go in for the full treatment. It is hard; but the sort of compromise we are all hankering after is harder—in fact, it is impossible. It may be hard for an egg to turn into a bird: it would be a jolly sight harder for it to learn to fly while remaining an egg. We are like eggs at present. And you cannot go on indefinitely being just an ordinary, decent egg. We must be hatched or go bad."

It does not matter if it is hard for us to listen to the Holy Ghost, we must do it. If we will listen to Him, God will always provide the light to show us where "We have erred, and strayed from His ways like lost sheep. Where we have followed too much the devices and desires of our own hearts. Where we have offended against His holy laws. Where we have left undone those things which we ought to have done; And we have done those things which we ought not to have done¹..." He does this so that we might return to His Path. He does not show us where we have erred for no reason, but rather that we might use His Light to return to the path which brings us to His World. Then we can shine that Light for others to see, that they might pick up their torches and bring His Light into the darkness of the world, be it the Western Civilized Word or the Eastern World. First, we have to let His Light into our hearts before we can shine it to others that they may see the works of His Light. Then we shall transform the world from total darkness, to that of a total light. At least that is what we are always striving to work towards, even when evil is often thwarting our efforts to the maximum. If evil is thwarting our efforts then we all must put in 110% to stop evil and combat it across the world wherever it is. We must never, never, never, ever give up on this fight.

We must fight evil wherever and whenever we run across it. We must not let the little

and big evils in this life get us down or defeat us. We must rely on the guiding power of the Holy Ghost and God's unlimited grace to save the day. His Grace can help you out of any horrific situation, but first you have to ask and accept His help, which is a universal theme in our sermons here, because it is a truth and one that Jesus preached, that is that we have to accept Him into our hearts, if we are to become truly Christians.

A couple years ago, I met a Navy SEAL in Guam, who gave an excellent sermon to the point we must be on the offense in the battle against Satan, never defense. The SEAL noted Paul did not describe any sort of back armor whatsoever, showing us Christianity was an offense based, not defense based religion. We must never our back towards the enemy, but rather face forward and attack. The best defense is a good offense as in every case. We must never cease our fight against Satan, for he is powerful here on earth, tricking many. We are often outnumbered in the fight. Numbers matter not. We must always fight with all we have every time. We must carry on; we must storm the beaches of Hell itself, and keep on persevering in good times and in bad.

Paul tells us if we follow Christ's example, we will live lives like His to the extent we can. We will do good, be law abiding, work hard, be generous to our fellow human beings, help where we can, pray for help when we can find no physical way to help. It may be hard to give physical help, but if you are generous and prayerful, you can often do good even when physical help is next to impossible. Be good citizens, be good neighbors, take particular care of our Christian family. In short, do what Christ would do as far as it is in us. Let us do our best to think in hard and trying times, what would Jesus do in our situation, and then act in a manner most like Him. In order to make the world a better place, we first have to start with our selves then work out word, applying the principles of Christ to our lives. God does not ask us to be perfect; He does ask us to do our best to try to be perfect, to follow Jesus' lead to the extent we have it in us. Each of us is different, some are in truth less bad than others. God holds us each to the same standard, that is to do our best. Not to be better than any other particular person, but to do our best to follow His Instructions. Being better than someone else is of no account, what is of account is following His Instructions to the best of YOUR ability.

Don't think of trying to be better than your neighbor, think of being better than you are. Be better than you were yesterday, if you do this, then you will improve day by day, year by year.

In the Gospel according to Saint John, Jesus tells of His impending bodily death and resurrection. He reminds us if we have eternal life, sorrow, even the sorrow of death is transient, for He has conquered death. Any irritations or sorrows, large ones or small ones, are in the large scheme of things (eternity that is) very small and insignificant compared to our future with Him in heaven. We have to keep this in mind throughout our travel along the straight and narrow upward path. His One Sacrifice, made One Time, for All Mankind, for All Time is that joy that no man can take from us. But, if we want to share in that eternal life, we need to see the error of our ways in the Light of His Light and take actions to follow Him.

Often it seems much easier to take the path of least resistance, to quit our work at the first sign of effort, to goof off when "no one" is looking. But in the end, the right thing to do is always the easiest, the most profitable. The one that will result in happiness. It might seem hard, but it will not be as hard as doing the "easy" thing.

The time is now, not tomorrow. The time has come, indeed. How will you ACT?

It is by our actions we are known.

As we go off on our business, please recall this quote from GK Chesterton:

Christianity has not been tried and found wanting; it has been found difficult and not tried.

LMIGHTY God, who showest to them that are in error the light of thy truth, to the intent that they may return into the way of righteousness; Grant unto all those who are admitted into the fellowship of Christ's



Religion, that they may avoid those things that are contrary to their profession, and follow all such things as are agreeable to the same; through our Lord Jesus Christ. *Amen.*

Today I'd like to reflect on the epistle reading saving the Gospel reading for another time and another message. The epistle reading sets an interesting tone. When St. Peter writes this you can almost hear the conversation going on in his head. He was most likely thinking back to that tragic late night event that would culminate in the death on the Cross of his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. He had promised the Lord that he would not leave him, even to the point of death; and yet in the space of several hours he denies his Lord three times. Each person who connected Peter to the man on trial looked at the disciple and affirmed the close relationship of the two.

Each time, Peter would deny knowing Christ. Each time was like a hammer blow such as the ones that would affix the Christ to the Cross. Now, years later, Peter writes about the very practical nature of living the Gospel among the lost. He quietly points out what we ought to do in our daily lives as we live among those who do not believe in the Savior.

Remember, we are being watched:

- 1. Abstain from fleshly lusts. This activity can be observed by others. You laugh at an off colored joke, a sit-com, a scantily clad individual (equal opportunity lusts). Each of those actions are observed by non-believers, they check out your reaction to the situation and see what a "Christian" does. Very telling. We have all been there.
- 2. When we talk with unbelievers, who do we comport ourselves? Do we add to the gossip, do we go along to get along, do we pass on rumors and innuendos about other? IF we have honest conversations, even if the unbeliever speaks against you, they must agree that your honesty is what sets you apart from others, so even they

who are evildoers, will recognize God in you, God will be glorified by your daily walk with Him.

3. Submit to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake. Whoa, this is a hard one. How often do we exceed the speed limit? What little short cuts do we take as we live our lives that may or are against set law or ordinances? Remember, in the truest sense, little ones are watching. If you understand that the unbeliever is really a babe in life, they are the ones who need to see the Lord honored and glorified, then we must take care in our behavior. Daily. Yikes, that is a hard one.

By submitting to the laws and ordinances, we are exhibiting our desire to honor God, the supreme governor, He who is on His Throne.

4. Now comes the civic part of the lesson. God has placed all of authority in that position. So that being said, we must obey the authority that God has put in place. I can already hear you saying but "what about the bad authorities?". To which I ask you, what did Sts. Paul and Peter write about during their time? Both apostles wrote about submitting to the authority at hand. When you have time, read about the 12 Caesars. Those first Roman emperors were a real mixed bag of rulers. You have a couple of downright evil caesars, a couple of really decent caesars, and a few who were ok, but not much to write home about. But in each case, they were the rulers of the empire at hand, and were to be obeyed as per the writings of Paul and Peter. Why?

Each king or governor had a job. They were/are in power to punish evildoers and...yes and to praise those who did well. Why? "...for so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men:".

Now let us conclude this civic lesson. What do we do with the liberty and freedom that comes with being counted among the elect? When God redeems us through his Son, we now have a duty to behave as a child of the King and to behave as a citizen of Heaven.

5. So with our expensively bought freedom from Death. (Christ death upon the Cross), we should not use said freedom foolishly. We are not to use it to hide our malicious nature or behavior, we are not to use it to sooth our evil desires. No, we are to honor all men. (made in the image of God), we are to love our fellow believers, we are to serve God and most especially, we are to fear Him, honor Him, for He is our Creator.

Our experience as a free people does make it hard for us to understand the majesty of the King of kings, the Lord of lords. We are a people, who in a civic sense, crave our freedoms. We are a people who do not like to be told what to do, and yet we must understand that the Kingdom of Heaven is just that, a kingdom. No one elects the king. No one votes a majority on rules and regulations, no one is going to live in a democracy in heaven. No, it is a monarchy. The King of the Universe will rule...forever and ever....AMEN.

17 Honour all men. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king.

ALMIGHTY God, the fountain of all wisdom, who knowest our necessities before we ask, and our ignorance in asking; We beseech thee to have compassion upon our infirmities; and those things which for our unworthiness we dare not, and for our blindness we cannot ask, vouchsafe to give us, for the worthiness of thy Son Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen*.

Rev Bryan Dabney of Saint John's Sunday Sermon

We are fortunate to have Bryan's Sunday Sermon. If you want people to come to The Truth, you have to speak the truth, espouse the truth and live

the truth. This is really a good piece and I commend it to your careful reading.

Third Sunday after Easter

In today's Epistle, the apostle Peter referred to Christians as, *strangers and pilgrims* (I St. Peter 2:11). How true, for it is, after all, quite understandable for the Bible-believing Christian to find himself or herself "on the outs" as it were, in today's world. We are "on the outs" because we have chosen to follow a different path— one which leads to life everlasting in God's kingdom—



as opposed to that wide path that leads to destruction (St. Matthew 7:13-14).

The word 'stranger' is translated from the Greek word *pariokos* which Thayer's Lexicon describes as being, "one who lives as a stranger and sojourner upon the earth". The word 'pilgrim' in Greek is *parepidemos* and is translated as "one who comes from a foreign place to reside in a new land." Taken together, they speak of our status as believing Christians

with regard to this world system, and how we are to live within the same. Their meaning is clear and may be expressed in this way: If we be in Christ Jesus, then we are not of this world. In point of fact, we are estranged from it.

Consider our Lord's words following the Last Supper when prayed for the disciples as well as for all who would accept him as their Saviour: ...*They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world* (St. John 17:16). And the apostle John warned us to, *Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him* (I St. John 2:15). And St. Paul noted that, *Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual (I Corinthians 2:12-13).*

Think on that for a moment. As born-again believers in Jesus Christ, we have received the Holy Ghost who guides us into all truth. We are no longer alive to this world system but have died to it being reborn into a new life and a new way of living. The apostle Peter noted that, Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: for he that hath suffered in the flesh hath ceased from sin; that he no longer should live the rest of his time in the flesh to the lusts of men, but to the will of God. For the time past of our life may suffice us to have wrought the will of the Gentiles... wherein they think it strange that ye run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you... (I St. Peter 4:1-4). Ergo, our Lord expects us to be strangers to sin, that is, we are to distance ourselves from it. In our parlance, to be a stranger means being unfamiliar with someone or some thing. Strangers stand out. They appear detached. And because they are these things, they are often shunned as being "odd" or "different", even "alien". And we are pilgrims who are seeking a new place to live— a better country, that is an heavenly: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: for he hath prepared for them a city (Hebrews 11:16). Just like the Pilgrims of Plymouth Rock, we are in search of a new home— a place where we will be accepted into the beloved. That new land we are looking for is God's coming kingdom. But those who merely call themselves by the name of Christ, yet do not live in Christ, are not "on the outs" with this world. Their continued participation in those behaviors and practices which the regenerate person might find repugnant mark them as acceptable, or at least tolerable, to the unregenerate masses. In short, these so-called Christians are enamored of the things of this world, and are thus captivated by them. As they are more natural than spiritual, so it follows that they will fall prey to the snares and devices which the devil sets for them. As the apostle Paul noted, But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned (I Corinthians 2:14). He also warned the Philippian church to, mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample. (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ: whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind earthly things) (3:17-19).

We have been warned by our Lord and the apostles to avoid hypocrisy in our living the Christian life. You cannot run here and there amongst the heathen of this world and not be tainted by their godlessness. That said, we cannot leave the world until we are called home. So, for us, being in society does not mean being involved in its several evils even though we are surrounded by them. We are to note such and abstain from all appearance of evil (I Thessalonians 5:22).

While many Christians have established boundaries for themselves concerning their participation within secular society, still one can join in with those things that will not hurt their consciences. But a caveat is in order. We should be mindful that while there are

things which are not unbiblical that we mayenjoy; we should not be surprised to find a wicked angle that might lead us into situations where our faith might be compromised and our witness diminished by our participation in them. Therefore be discerning. Stay in control. Keep the commandments of God before you and the words of our Saviour. Avoid those things that would taint or vex your spirit.

Just ask yourself: "Will my participation in whatever I want to do harm my Christian witness?" or, better yet, "Would God approve of what I am doing?" St. Paul once said that, *All things are lawful for me, but all things are not expedient: all things are lawful for me, but all things are not expedient: all things are lawful for me, but all things edify not* (I Corinthians 10:23). Doing what is expedient and edifying may often be challenging for us when we are being coaxed to act by those friends and family members who are as yet outside the fold of Christ. So, whatever you do, make sure that you are right with God and that you stay in control so that the devil cannot turn your good into something evil, and that your good will not be evil spoken of (Romans 14:16).

The path of the stranger and the pilgrim is often a lonely course as the true and faithful Christian will not be part of the vast herd of mankind that is merrily on its way to perdition. The stranger and pilgrim in Christ is not a hermit— shunning participation in society— but is a witness— one who is standing in the open— revealing to those around them the true light of God's word written. We are beacons in a sin-darkened world. We are the bearers of God's light— candles on lampstands, blazing with the fire of the Holy Ghost. The stranger and pilgrim in Christ has been commanded by our Lord to do exactly that (St. Matthew 5:16).

So then let us be about our business. Let each of you purpose today to be that separated person— that stranger— that pilgrim— in Christ. Seek to separate yourselves from the world, the flesh and the devil. The apostle Paul once penned this passage for us regarding separation from evil in this life when he wrote, *Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness? and what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? and what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, and will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty (II Corinthians 6:14-18).*

This do and live.

Let us pray,

OMOST gracious and loving God, who art a Father to all who truly call upon thy name; bless us with wisdom and understanding so that we might better serve thee in this life by being effective witnesses on your behalf; and these things we ask in the name of him who is our Lord and Saviour, even Jesus Christ. *Amen*.
