For the Epistle. Acts i. 1.

HE former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach, until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen: to whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God: and, being assembled together with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me. Remember these events of the day Christ ascended to the Father:

⁴⁴ And he said unto them, These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me. ⁴⁵ Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures, ⁴⁶ And said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day: ⁴⁷ And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. ⁴⁸ And ye are witnesses of these things. ⁴⁹ And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high. ⁵⁰ And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he lifted up his hands, and blessed them. ⁵¹ And it came to pass, while he blessed them, he was parted from them, and carried up into heaven. ⁵² And they worshipped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy: ⁵³ And were continually in the temple, praising and blessing God. Amen. (Luke 24:44-53)

Can a physical body exist in more than one place at a time? Jesus must return to the Father in order that the whole world might receive the witness of the Comforter – the Holy Ghost. The Holy Ghost is a spirit and may be in all places at all times. Do not offend the Holy Spirit, who is always with you, by vile and sinful living. We have the very serious warning against bringing the Holy Spirit into an environment which is unholy:

²⁷ No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house. ²⁸ Verily I say unto you, All sins shall be forgiven unto the sons of men, and blasphemies wherewith soever they shall blaspheme: ²⁹ But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation: (Mark 3:27-29)

Jesus made this observation as a result of the scribes and Pharisees claiming that Christ worked miracles through the spirit of Beelzebub. Beelzebub is a demon spirit. The Holy Spirit must not be offended in this hateful manner. All that we do in the presumed privacy of a dark room are performed in the presence of the Holy Spirit. Consider the Holy Spirit to be similar to your loving mother. Would you do some of the things you do in her presence – Vulgar language, sex, drinking, smoking, cursing?

Would you allow your friends to use vile language in the presence of your mother who bore you? Do you honor your father and your mother enough? Do you honor the Holy Spirit who lives in your heart?

And what of your heart? Who is its guardian? Who dwells there?

No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house.

Before you invited Christ into your heart, who was its Ruler? Satan, himself. Satan was the Strong Man of your heart. But Christ is stronger. Invite Jesus Christ into your heart, and He will bind Satan and clean up the entire house. Can we clean up our hearts? No, we must invite Christ to do so. And He will!

The world, or, in reality, every one's own heart, is—we have the authority of Christ to say it—"a house" or a palace, which Satan, as a strong man, holds and keeps. So long as the strong man holds his palace on an undisputed tenure, it is all quiet; his goods are in peace. But when Christ, who is represented as the stronger One, comes, there is warfare—warfare to the death; and thus warfare in the breast is the first, and for a long while the only, token for good. There are three stages, then, which we will examine in order:

- 1 First, "the strong man armed keepeth his palace." The strong one—none know how strong, but those who try to escape and break off his tyranny—so strong, that his strength is unseen, while in stillness and in silence he holds his own; so strong that the greatest determination of the most strong-minded man, unaided, trying to break any one of those many bonds, would be as if he were to try to uproot a mountain. A prison is a strong fortress. One man cannot break it's bars. But when a mighty Army comes, it shall yield to the overwhelming power of strength.
- 2 But the stronger comes, and now the fighting begins. Unknown to you, the stronger is binding the strong one. Heavy blasts blew, bitter winds came, and severe discipline and desolating bereavements fell upon you; but they were never meant to hurt you; they were to kill the strong one, the power of evil that is in you.
- 3 Now mark the spoil. He will bind the strong man, and then he will spoil his house. The habit of sin broken, the power of sin reduced, the love of sin destroyed—the soul is emancipated; and now Christ is free to claim His own property, which His own blood has purchased, and His own right hand has rescued. Has He not a right? Are not all the spoils His? So once, two thousand years ago, when He had gained the victory over the whole world by His death, and when He had led captivity captive "up to the highest heaven," He took His seat before the throne, and distributed to men, from His royal greatness, the good things which, by that death, He had redeemed from Satan's grasp. Then, the outpourings of the day of Pentecost—then the largesse's of pardon, life, grace, joy, wisdom, service, love, heaven, which from His throne He is always pouring upon men. He had bound the strong man on Calvary. He had restored the property to the lawful owner, and then He ascended into the heaven of heavens, and "divided the spoils."

Life is affected by two different forces. I. The strong enemy – Satan. II. The strong friend – Christ! Man must be under one or other of these forces, the enemy or the friend. Those who continue under the devil will share the ruin to which he is doomed. "When Satan's head is bruised, all who are in Satan's empire will be crushed." ~ Dr. Parker We can belong to only one of two families – that of Heaven, or that of Hell. The day is coming when some of you will be persecuted for your faith. But that is OK. It means that you belong to Christ. These things have I spoken unto you, that ye should not be offended. They shall put you out of the synagogues: yea, the time cometh, that whosoever killeth you will think that he doeth God service. (John 15) Who murders innocent victims today believing they do God a service? Have you witnessed the throat cuttings of the moslem fanatics in the Middle East? They bind their victims, who have done nothing wrong, and cut their throats while singing, "Allah Ahk-Bar!" - "God is Great!" So you can be sure the day is coming when many shall die for Christ. Today, we have a moslem president who has tried to claim that America is not a Christian nation. Do you believe him? He refuses to refer to the Islamic extremists as "radical moslems⁴". But they are so. Have you been kicked out of a church for your faith? I have been. So will you if you stand on biblical doctrine. Why do the evil rage? Because they do not

know God. Why? Because we have not told them of Him and given evidence in our own lives of Him! Christ has ascended to the Father where He prepares a place for us. We must wait our days here on earth and also build our place upon a solid foundation. Hear the words Christ uses to describe our building and living: 24 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock: 25 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock. 26 And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand: 27 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall thereof. (Matthew 7)

What kind of foundation are you building your lives upon? The Rock of Christ, or the Sand of Satan?

Propers

Each Sunday there are Propers: special prayers and readings from the Bible. There is a Collect for the Day; that is a single thought prayer, most written either before the refounding of the Church of England in the 1540s or written by Bishop Thomas Cranmer, the first Archbishop of Canterbury after the re-founding.

The Collect for the Day is to be read on Sunday and during Morning and Evening Prayer until the next Sunday. The Epistle is normally a reading from one of the various Epistles, or letters, in the New Testament. The Gospel is a reading from one of the Holy Gospels, Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. The Collect is said by the minister as a prayer, the Epistle can be read by either a designated reader (as we do in our church) or by one of the ministers and the Holy Gospel, which during the service in our church is read by an ordained minister.

The propers are the same each year, except if a Red Letter Feast, that is one with propers in the prayerbook, falls on a Sunday, then those propers are to be read instead, except in a White Season, where it is put off. Red Letter Feasts, so called because in the Altar Prayerbooks the titles are in red, are special days. Most of the Red Letter Feasts are dedicated to early saints instrumental in the development of the church, others to special events. Some days are particularly special and the Collect for that day is to be used for an octave (eight days) or an entire season, like Advent or Lent.

The Propers for today are found on Page 179-180, with the Collect first:

This morning's Epistle is written in the Fourth Chapter of the First Epistle of Saint Peter

beginning at the Seventh Verse. Peter reminds us of the shortness of our lives, the eternity of the next world and implores us to live as if we were eternal now, not wait until we die. For the, eternity will be a bit late.

HE end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer. And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins. Use hospitality one to another without grudging. As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. *Amen*.

Today's Holy Gospel came from the Fifteenth Chapter of the Gospel according to Saint John beginning at the Twenty-Sixth Verse. The Gospel talks about the origin of the Holy Ghost and the reason for which He is being sent. It also foretells the enmity that Christians will find from those of this world who do not share their understanding of God and His Will:

HEN the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me: and ye also shall bear witness, because ye have been with me from the beginning. These things have I spoken unto you, that ye should not be offended. They shall put you out of the synagogues: yea, the time cometh, that whosoever killeth you will think that he doeth God service. 

THESE words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee: 2 As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him. 3 And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent. 4 I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do. 5 And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was. 6 I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word. 7 Now they have known that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee. 8 For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me. 9 I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine. 10 And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them. 11 And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. (John 17:1-26 - (Second Lesson, First Propers – same for Maundy Thursday)

How can we adequately contemplate the great events of this day, and the greater events of tomorrow, without a deep sense of remorse, sorrow, and serious penitence? This text today contains some of the most beautiful words and pleas that can be found in scripture. There are, too, mysteries that escape the competence of man to define or explain. How is that we came to Christ – by our own volition and goodness, or by the foreordination and predestination of God? Was it one or the other, or was it both? Many learned men have addressed the issue and the results are a torn and divided church. The Calvinists believe that they have discovered the rock bottom of truth. The Arminians, as well, believe that they have the exclusive knowledge of truth as regards the matter. Each condemns members of the other party to damnation. But, of course, that is not our role as Christians. We may differ fundamentally on the meaning of passages of scripture, but

we can condemn no man for his having another interpretation as long as he is using scripture and a modicum of reason and logic to arrive at that interpretation. The traditional Anglican view is to accept that there are mysteries of which we may have little comprehension. The Thirty Nine Articles of Religion define our doctrine on these matters, and they are authoritative – but they are authoritative only insofar as they are drawn from Biblical Truth. I have studied ten different commentaries on these Articles and have found not a single flaw in their Biblical truth and expression. So let us arm ourselves to do battle with Satan and his legions, and not do internecine battle with each other on matters that we may not have mastered or which may not affect our security in Christ. If we are redeemed of the Lord, we shall know it at any rate!

1 These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee: 2 As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him. 3 And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus *Christ, whom thou hast sent.* This entire chapter is a prayer – the longest in the New Testament – given at a moment of great grief for our Lord. The disciples are walking with Christ on the way to Gethsemane. The prayer takes on a more meaningful ambience when uttered beneath the starlit sky. When the only source of light and comfort can be found from Heaven, it is appropriate to lift one's eyes to that source. I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help. 2 My help cometh from the LORD, which *made heaven and earth.* (Psalm 121:1-2) The desire of the ages is coming due in its season. Eternity has suffered and labored to bring about the redemption of the race of man from the curse of Eden. It is now the time of Christ to fulfill all things – to suffer, redeem, and save us from our sins. If we are Christian, we must accept the authority of Scripture in all things. We are told that there can be no separation between God the Father and God the Son. To reject the Son is to reject the Father. This being a given of scripture, how is it possible for evangelicals and reformed ministers to declare that we Christians worship the same God as Allah? Does Allah know Christ? Does Allah have a Holy Ghost? Does Allah have redeeming mercy? The questions are rhetorical for it is obvious on the face of the matter that Allah does not resemble the goodness of God even by the most charitable standards. Allah brings, as did Hagar, bondage to sin and a continual judgment. God offers liberty through the merits of His Son and the efficacious testimony of the Holy Ghost.

4 I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do. 5 And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was. 6 I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word. Notice that Christ speaks in the past perfect tense regarding His finishing the work His Father had given – sinless and holy life, His miracles, His death and resurrection, and salvation for men who responded to the faith. To be sure, the work was accomplished in Christ before the worlds were made when it was decided that a Savior must come. When the Lord gives His Word, the matter is as good as accomplished. Those who came to Christ were given by the Father. These, too, have kept the Word for such is the nature of the people of God.

7 Now they have known that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee. 8 For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me. Christ is earnest to give glory of the Word to His father, but, in fact, Christ is the incarnation of that Word. The Father has given the Son, and the son has

given Himself from the Father. The circle of Love is complete. The disciples, except for the son of perdition, have all alike received the Word, have understood the Word in things necessary, and know that the Father and the Son are One.

<u>o I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine.</u> 10 And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them. As an inquiring young boy growing up, I often heard sermons from the pulpit that seemed to suggest God looked upon all – both the lost and the saved of Christ – with the same devotion and care. This was long a puzzle to me. Why should those who rejected His only Begotten Son be viewed by God with the same attentive compassion? I have learned since that this notion was never true. There are only two families upon the face of the earth – those who are the Elect of God, and those who have rejected Him. These latter ones belong to their father the devil as Christ charged the Pharisees. Christ here does not pray for the world, but for the chosen from out of the world.

11 And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are. 12 While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled. 13 And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves. 14 I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. Does it not warm your heart to know that such depth of compassion springs from the heart of Christ on the eve of His Passion? Christ will be leaving the world since His work is finished here, but we will be left to fend alone among the wolves and carnivores of the world. He prays that God will keep us together in the Spirit of One family. Important to note is the fact that Christ loses none who have come into His hands. If you have come into the estate of the blessed, neither shall you be lost for He shall keep you in security. Because of the Word (truth) the world hates Christ, but also the followers of Christ. The world will receive us better if we compromise that Word, and far too many have done so; but God's grip on our souls is solid in our faithfulness to Him.

15 I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil. 16 They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. 17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth. 18 As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world. 19 And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth. Remember the illustration of the ship made for the sea, to navigate the sea and to carry burdens of blessing across it? That is what the Christian is in the world. He navigates through the world. He bears burdens of blessing for the world, but when there is a breach and the sea gets into the ship, or the world gets into the Christian, both will founder. Christ sends us out into the world for the benefit of the world, but not so that we will become part of it. Christ separated Himself from the world, not only because of His own choosing, but also for our benefit. If He remains pure and sanctified, so should we be inspired to be.

20 Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; 21 That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. 22 And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: 23 I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me. Do you realize that Christ prayed for YOU the night preceding His Passion? He has done so if you have believed through the words of the Apostles and Gospel writers. He did not only have a

following that was One with the Father 2,000 years ago, He has ones called out from the four corners of the world today who are One with Christ, One with the Father, and One with every other believer – past, present, or future. What a privilege and a blessing to know that the Father loves us in the same way that He loves His dear Son. The amazing quality of love is that it never diminishes when shared, but grows more abundant in volume.

24 Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world. 25 O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me. 26 And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them. If you harbor any false belief Jesus became the son of God 2,000 years ago in Bethlehem, perish that thought! He has ever been with the Father from Eternity Past to Eternity Future. Our ultimate responsibility is to engender that same divine love in our hearts that sill most resemble that unconditional kind of love that exists in the heart of the Father and His dear Son our Lord. Is our love today a detached kind of love for others, or is it a vibrant, living, sacrificial love that is like that of Christ? The chains of bondage shall be severed on the morrow!

Sermon – Reverend Jack Arnold - Time and Action Church of the Faithful Centurion - Descanso, California

Today's sermon brought the Collect, Epistle and Gospel together and is partly contained in the forewords above.

Once again the propers for this week come together very well, their focus is narrow, thus powerful.

Consider these words from the Collect:

... leave us not comfortless; but send to us thine Holy Ghost to comfort us, and exalt us unto the same place whither our Saviour Christ is gone before ...

The Ascension having just happened, Jesus having ascended in to heaven, we are alone and separated from God who gives us strength. Like Peter, the further we are from God, the weaker we are. Thus, we are looking towards Pentecost and the arrival of the Holy Ghost. We ask for God's help that we might have

the true belief, courage, knowledge and strength to follow Jesus to heaven for all eternity.

While the end of the earth and this world may come at any time, for 313,000 people each day, their time here is up. Thus, in a very real sense as Saint Peter put it, "The end of all things is at hand..." So, how should we act? We are to do what we can with a smile on our face. We should act as if it was our last day on earth. We need to be mindful of the fact that at any time, the world could end for each of us. In other words, if this was our last day on this planet, how would we act? That is a question I must ask myself more often and not only ask it, but answer it. The answer comes with the help of the Holy Ghost, who could only come once Jesus left. That is one of the reasons why Jesus ascended into heaven. He left so the Holy Ghost could come down and live amongst us and provide us with the guidance we need to follow God.

We have to wait and hear what the Holy Ghost has to say before we act. Then once the

Holy Spirit has given the answer, we must act upon that answer. This is a continuous cycle and we must always prioritize our work to be for God, our Country and Family in that order and things will fall in line. Along these lines, we should strive to work hard, take care of those who cannot and be good stewards of the considerable grace God has given us. This does not just refer to spending MONEY, but rather to giving of our time and effort to bring the Gifts of God to others. We must give ourselves entirely to help others, so that we may share the benefits of the Gift of God truly. Only then we will know the grace of God's love truly. We are to share the LOVE in our hearts with those we encounter, for Love is of God. And the Holy Ghost will help us spread that love to others in our lives. We are called not to hoard that love, but to spread it through ought our travels. For as love is of God, then it follows there is a large supply of love. In fact, love multiplies with use, so there is an even more infinite amount of love out there.

For as Saint Peter says in his Epistle this morning, charity (love) truly does cover a multitude of sins. So, when we do things for others, the driving force behind our actions should be that of charity, or love, for our fellow human beings and not any self-seeking motivation. Charity will cover for our multitude of sins, but we need to be thinking of how we can use charity in our hearts to help others. It is one of the greatest gifts God and the Holy Spirit gives to us; it is a gift we find ourselves needing to use more often. The Holy Spirit is key in giving us the desirable thoughts and attributes that we need to carry out His Plan on Earth. He also helps us deal with our less desirable thoughts and attributes and helps us deal with very difficult people and situations. I have found that to be the case in plenty of those difficult situations. Turning to the Holy Spirit in those very stressful times will reduce the burden on your heart and shift it from you to God, giving you the clarity you need to act for Him, to be able to act in an effective and Christ like manner.

But, without the Holy Ghost, the needed action on our part is impossible. We need God's help and He sent it in the form of the Holy Ghost. He sent it as the "Comforter", that is to Comfort us and to Guide us on the journey on the narrow uphill path towards heaven. The Holy Ghost is that portion of God who can enter our hearts bringing understanding, hope and most of all the courage and determination to do what needs be done. Those who will not have Him in their hearts can never understand God and His Will. That is why they cannot understand or fathom the plan He has for us. They cannot understand why we follow God and Christ. They do not believe; therefore, they cannot have Him in their hearts, and therefore they will not understand. The end of time is nearer each day than the day before, of that we can be certain. But there is a certainty we have in this uncertainly world, the unfailing love of our Lord and Saviour Jesus and the presence of the Holy Ghost in our lives, if we let Him in, and the inerrant Holy Scriptures to guide us throughout the rest of our lives. With this knowledge of an unchanging standard, we can stand fast by this standard and be content knowing we are following the One True Triune God, and though we may suffer a while, it is nothing to enjoying eternity with God. We just have to DO and ACT our best for Him here; though it may be hard, it will be worth it in the end. The current climate in the world and even in this country is less hospitable than in centuries to Christians. There is a reason for this which only God understands and not us. God has a plan for all of this. In time, we will realize what the plan is. But for now, we are unaware of His plan in the greater scheme of things. But what it is doing is solidifying the faith of true believers around the globe, forming the Army of Light together, ready to battle against the malicious forces of Satan. We cannot make this journey alone. We must have the close and continuous presence of God. That presence is the Holy Ghost. That is why He is here.

Pray for His continual presence in your heart.

Heaven is at the end of an uphill trail. The easy downhill trail does not lead to the summit.

The time is now, not tomorrow. The time has come, indeed. How will you ACT? It is by our actions we are known.

Be of God - Live of God - Act of God

Bishop Dennis Campbell's Sermon

Bishop Dennis is a brilliant speaker. He is able to take biblical precepts and make them perfectly understandable, even to me. Oft he provides the text of his sermons and I take the utmost pleasure in

passing them on:

Why We still Believe 1 Peter 4:7- 11, John 15:26-16:4 Sunday after Ascension May 28, 2017

The Christian faith is either revealed truth from God, or it is just one of many made up stories that we can identify

with or not as we choose. Christian morality is either God's law binding upon all people at all times, or it is just another competing human view which we are free to accept or reject as we please. Yet billions of people down through history, many of them the brightest lights of humanity, have earnestly believed the Christian faith is truth from God. Even today billions of people still believe. The World Council of Churches claims to have 590 million members. There are over 330,000 protestant denominations. 300 million people are part of the Eastern Orthodox Church. 1.2 billion people are Roman Catholics. A variety of beliefs and approaches, each of them call themselves Christians. So, the fact is, they believe they are, and that raises a question; why, in this, "enlightened" age, do so many still believe? Why do we still cling to Christianity?

We still cling to Christianity because we believe it is the faith given by God. We say this because we believe Jesus Christ brought the Christian faith to us, and we believe Jesus Christ was is and forever will be, God. We believe He is the word who was with God and who was God in John 1:1. We believe He is the word who became flesh in John 1:14. We believe Him when He said in John 10:30, "I and my Father are one, "and in John 8:18, "the Father that sent me beareth witness of me," and, "he that hath seen me hath seen the Father" in John 14:9. Thus we agree fully with Hebrews 1:1 and 2, "God, who at sundry times and in diverse manners spake in times past unto the fathers by the prophets, hath in these last days spoken to us by his Son."

How did God speak to us in His Son Jesus Christ? He spoke to us in the teaching of Jesus. Jesus came to teach us about God. He said, "I do nothing of myself; but as the Father hath taught me, I speak these things" (John 8:18). Looking through the Bible we see Jesus spending most of His time teaching about God. We see the Sermon on the Mount. We see Him teaching in the synagogues and in the Temple. We especially see Him teaching the men who would become His Apostles. We see Him taking them aside for special times of private instruction. He even spent time teaching them after His resurrection.

Thus, on the Emmaus road, "beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself" (Luke 24:27).

It was these same men that He commissioned to be His witnesses, preaching the same faith He gave to them. They were "ambassadors for Christ" (2 Cor. 5:20), and "stewards of the mysteries of God" (1 Cor 4:1). They were to proclaim only what they had received from Christ, the very same faith He taught, the very word of Christ.. They were to "preach the word," as the Apostle Paul wrote to Timothy (2 Tim 4:1). And they were to pass that same word on to others, who were to pass it on to others, and so it will continue down through the generations (2 Tim. 2:2).

So, we believe the Christian faith is given to the world by God, and taught in the Church from the time of Christ to this very moment. It was preserved by God through the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit enabled the Apostles to understand and preserve the faith. They preserved it by teaching it, and commissioning others to teach it. They also preserved it by recording it in the books and letters we now call the New Testament.

We believe God established a people, a kingdom, an organisation called the Church, and a major part of its purpose is to preserve and proclaim the faith. given to it. We believe the Church was established by God, for Christ Himself said, "on this rock I will build my church." We believe all Christians are to be active and faithful members of the Church. For Hebrews 10:25 tells us not to absent ourselves from its meetings. Christ gave the faith to the Church and the Bible calls Christianity the faith once delivered to the saints. This is why St. Paul calls the Church the pillar and ground of truth, because it preserves the faith given to it by Christ.

For two thousand years the Church has struggled to preserve the faith. It has been persecuted by enemies, and untold numbers of her people have died in Coliseums and dungeons and on crosses, rather than give up the faith. It has been torn by heresy. I said earlier that I have a hard time calling some people Christians. That is because so many of them have adopted other gospels and given up on the faith given by Christ. This is not surprising to us, for the Bible itself says the time will come when people will not endure sound doctrine, and will turn away from the truth to fables. I submit to you that many who call themselves Christians today are actually following fables rather than truth. Yet God has His remnant, His people who have not bowed the knee to other gods or departed from the faith. It is this Invisible Church within the Church that is the true Church. And, though not perfect in either faith or practice, not even close to perfection, this Church continues in the faith, and always will.

That brings me to this present moment and this very place. It brings me to we who call ourselves Christians here and now. The faith has been given. It has come to us at great cost and much suffering. It is ours to believe, to treasure, and to preserve, and to hand down to future generations. Having it makes us stewards of the manifold grace of God, as the Apostle Peter wrote in the passage we read earlier this morning. But I note that Peter didn't just call us stewards of the grace of God. He told us to do certain things, "as good stewards of the manifold grace of God." He is saying that having the grace of God makes us its stewards. Now we must decide whether to be bad stewards, or good stewards. God help to be good stewards.

Sunday after the Ascension

28 May 2017 Psalm 46,47 • Isaiah 32:1-4,15-20 • John 3:16-21, 31-36a

The Exalted One

The Sunday after Ascension Day. The Collect.

GOD, the King of glory, who hast exalted thine only Son Jesus Christ with great triumph unto thy kingdom in heaven; We beseech thee, leave us not comfortless; but send to us thine Holy Ghost to comfort us, and exalt us unto the same place whither our Saviour Christ is gone before, who liveth and reigneth with thee and the same Holy Ghost, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

Take some time this week to re-read the scripture set aside for this period of the church calendar, "Ascension-tide". Here we can see the culmination of Christ's time on earth, his bringing to a close the earthly ministry that was a mere three and a half years, and yet what a magnificent three and a half years! God's creation has experienced Immanuel, "God with us", and now mankind has the full experience of Salvation. The completeness of this salvation has now been revealed. What a time in the history of man. Let us look at some of our scripture for the day and see the wonderful work of God displayed.

If you notice, the Psalms and the reading from Isaiah both describe kingship. If we take a moment and reflect on the Ascension of Christ, we can see the parallels about kingship. First, in the psalms we read of a king, his kingdom established, the heathen are powerless against that kingdom. We read in the 47th Psalm the ascriptions of praise, befit a king. Here we read of some very strong foreshadowing of a coming king and his kingdom.

CLAP your hands, all ye people; shout unto God with the voice of triumph. For the Lord most high is terrible; he is a great King over all the earth.

- ³ He shall subdue the people under us, and the nations under our feet.
- ⁴ He shall choose our inheritance for us, the excellency of Jacob whom he loved. Selah.
- ⁵ God is gone up with a shout, the Lord with the sound of a trumpet.
- ⁶ Sing praises to God, sing praises: sing praises unto our King, sing praises.
- ⁷ For God is the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding.
- 8 God reigneth over the heathen: God sitteth upon the throne of his holiness.
- ⁹ The princes of the people are gathered together, even the people of the God of Abraham: for the shields of the earth belong unto God: he is greatly exalted.

Now let's look at the pure Gospel of St. John's message to all of mankind. In this most familiar of all passages of the Bible we see the work of God laid out in the life of Christ, who came to earth as we read earlier; Immanuel.

FOR God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. 17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. 18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. 19 And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. 20 For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. 21 But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God..."

Now in case beloved, you do not understand the full import of this previous passage, John then continues with the following:

31 He that cometh from above is above all: he that is of the earth is earthly, and speaketh of the earth: he that cometh from heaven is above all. 32 And what he hath seen and heard, that he testifieth; and no man receiveth his testimony. 33 He that hath received his testimony hath set to his seal that God is true. 34 For he whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto him. 35 The Father loveth the Son, and hath given all things into his hand. 36 He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him

I don't think you can misunderstand this passage. If you do not believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, then you are condemned and will not see life. Notice that even if you have not personally seen Christ on earth, you should believe the testimony of those who did.

This forty day period of time from Christ's resurrection until he ascended into heaven we know that at least 500 people saw him, who had seen him before his death on the Cross.

That is a pretty powerful testimony.

You might look at this period of time between Christ's Ascension and the coming of the Holy Spirit as the "calm before the storm". We have the disciples staying in Jerusalem, the others who followed Jesus possibly taking stock as what to do next. And yet all were most likely waiting with anticipation, not knowing exactly what was to come.

Some Bible commentators and theologians liken this time as the pre-church age. That with the coming of the Holy Spirit in a few days, the church, that group of believers,

He didn't just drop out of sight. Paul reports in 1 Corinthians 5-8 he and more than 500 other individuals saw Christ after he rose from the dead. In The 1928 Book of Common Prayer, pages 166-178, we read about others who saw the living Jesus after his Resurrection.

Ascension Day, the 40th day of Easter, was 25 May this year. Today is the Sunday after Ascension Day. On this day, writes Luke, Christ's disciples were the last to see him as he ascended into Heaven.

This is the day on which Christ the man takes his power as God the Son and reigns as King of Kings. As he is taken up, he blesses his disciples. Thus, his Ascension marks the end of his life on earth and the beginning of his life in Heaven.

Historians have pinpointed the time Paul recorded more than 500 sightings. He didn't just scribble down the first thing he heard. He collected a credible body of first-person sources as reports came to him over a

would be certified as the ongoing instrument of mission that Jesus instituted during his earthly ministry.

Suffice it to say, there would be a great change in the nature, attitude and mission thrust of the disciples and those who they trained in the coming years. The events that Jesus foretold in our Gospel passage would come to be. Not only would the disciple be thrown out of the synagogue, they would be persecuted, many would face death at the hands of Jewish and Roman legal systems. There were great changes that would be manifest in the life of the early church.

Do you think you would be up to the task? It is hard to say, in our relative comfort of the mostly calm United States. It isn't so with our brethren overseas. Our AOC parishes in Pakistan, India, parts of Africa, the South Sea Isles and the Philippines all face daily challenges and even death. It is getting more intense for believers especially on the Sub-Continent, as more and more militant groups gain power, not only the Islamist elements, but even militant Hindu and Buddhist groups too. All seemingly hell-bent on attacking their common enemy: Christians and the Cross that is "foolishness to them that perish". Let us pray for our fellow believers and those of the worldwide communion of the Anglican Orthodox Church.

GOD, who hast made of one blood all nations of men for to dwell on the face of the whole earth, and didst send thy blessed Son to preach peace to them that are far off and to them that are nigh; Grant that all men everywhere may seek after thee and find thee. Bring the nations into thy fold, pour out thy Spirit upon all flesh, and hasten thy kingdom; through the same thy Son Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen*.

A LMIGHTY God, our heavenly Father, in whose hands are the living and the dead; We give thee thanks for all those thy servants who have laid down their lives in the service of our country. Grant to them thy mercy and the light of thy presence, that the good work which thou hast begun in them may be perfected; through Jesus Christ thy Son our Lord. *Amen*.

DIRECT us, O Lord, in all our doings, with thy most gracious favour, and further us with thy continual help; that in all our works begun, continued, and ended in thee, we may glorify thy holy Name, and finally, by thy mercy, obtain everlasting life; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen*.



period of 25 years. Christ's death is thought to have taken place in 30 to 33 AD Paul wrote his letter to the Corinthians (the Church at Corinth) at around 55 AD.

In those days, communication spread around the ancient world at the speed of camel. Yet in merely 40 days from Resurrection to Ascension, Christ made known his presence to enough individuals who would spread the words like ripples --

[&]quot;He lives!" -- jm {1928 Prayer Book Alliance}

We are fortunate to have Bryan's Sunday Sermon. If you want people to come to The

Truth, you have to speak the truth, espouse the truth and live the truth. This is really a good piece and I commend it to your careful reading.

Sunday after Ascension Day

In today's Gospel, we read the words of our Lord at the Last Supper: But these things have I told you, that when the time shall come, ye may remember that I told you. Our Lord warned the disciples they would suffer persecution and rejection in their efforts to proclaim the gospel of truth. He advised them not to be offended. And in another place in Saint John's gospel, our



Lord said, *These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world, ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world* (16:33). We ought to be of good cheer. Being a saved person ought to fill us with gratitude and joy for what our Saviour has done for us. But in order for us to have that joy and his attendant peace that comes from his free gift of his grace, we must heed his word and commandments. Good advice.

Now a caveat is in order. No doubt you may well have received a lot of advice from family and friends over the years. But the advice we get from the Scriptures should be of paramount interest to us who bear the name of Christ. As Paul instructed young Timothy, All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: that the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works (II Timothy 3:16-17).

Now human wisdom and understanding are the only things the unregenerate have to go on. Since humanity at every level is fouled and flawed due to original sin, we can be certain that human wisdom, and its companion human understanding, are also flawed. This is not to say that such wisdom is totally false and to be ignored. But should we as Christians base our lives and our judgments on it as we would the Scriptures?

I remember a hearing an anecdote about one of my relations and his pre-Great Depression investments. This man was a lawyer and made a modest living as such. After returning from the France at the end of the Great War, he would occasionally purchase stock from his favorite brokerage firm. For nearly ten years, following the war, the stock market had been on an upward slant aside from a brief downturn in 1920. But by the summer of 1929, my relative decided to liquidate his holdings. His friend and broker tried to keep him in the market; but my relative would have nothing of it. He got his cash, brought it back home and put it in his office safe and returned to his practice of the law.

Then in October of that year, the stock market crashed and the Great Depression began. Almost overnight, vast fortunes, which had been tied up in stocks, banks and many insurance companies, were lost. The world economy slowed to a crawl. Those who were once the head became the tail or worse. It was then that my relative opened his safe and realized that he had made the right decision. He had taken the accumulated wisdom of the ages and utilized it to his advantage and that of his family. While economic times were hard in other households, he was able to take care of his family's needs and a few of their wants and desires all because he had been discerning.

As Christians, we have a source of advice which is far better than the kind my relative had followed. God our Father has provided us with a sort of heads-up on his plan and

purpose in the ages. You will find it set forth in the Holy Bible. For within its sacred pages, God has given us things to look for, signs and wonders to behold, all for the purpose of comforting us and keeping our focus on the coming his kingdom.

Consider now the word of God as found in the Book of Isaiah, Behold, the former things are come to pass, and new things do I declare: before they spring forth I tell you of them (42:9). In the Olivet Discourse, our Lord spoke of the end of days and his coming again in glory. He did this for the same reason that God informed the children of Israel through the prophets: so that they would know and would be able to point to those signs not as simply benchmarks in time, but events which would sustain and comfort them as they reveal God's hand within mankind's frame of reference. Our Lord said, And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh... Behold the fig tree, and all the trees; when they now shoot forth , ye see and know of your own selves that summer is now nigh at hand. So likewise ye, when ye see these things come to pass, know ye that the kingdom of God is nigh at hand (St. Luke 21:28-31).

I have heard people say from time to time that the prophecies of Scripture are too vague. They say it is pointless to study prophecy because there are so few specifics that such is akin to "reading tea leaves" or worse yet, "a horoscope". They complain that people are being misled by "end-time charlatans" who are out to make a buck through their latest book of the month which takes a few headlines which seem to fit the prophecies and then smile all the way to the bank with each new addition they publish.

While it is true that there are those who have used the end-times messages of Scripture for gain, we must remember to separate the message of God from our modern-day equivalents of Simon the Sorcerer— who sought personal profit from the beneficial aspects of the Holy Ghost (Acts 8:5-25). And God will judge those whose hearts were filled with greed for gain, as well as those who kept from their readers the whole counsel of God to the detriment of the gospel and the ruination of souls.

We know from the Scriptures that Christ will come again, and with that in mind we ought be witnessing to others regarding their salvation. As Paul observed in II Corinthians 6: 2, (... behold, now is the day of salvation.) Almost two thousand years ago, our Lord told us to, Watch, therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come (St. Matthew 24:42). He gave us that command because he desires all Christians to be like those wise virgins who took enough oil for their lamps so that they would be ready to serve and to celebrate the coming of the bridegroom (St. Matthew 25:1-13). God did not communicate his prophetic designs so that we would quit working. We are to watch for the signs which he has given us that we might warn the faltering that they not waver in their faith, and also encourage the unregenerate to have faith in Christ. Our Lord promised to go and prepare a place for us. He also promised that he will come again and bring us to it. O what comfort of joy there will be in that day of our gathering together in Christ (II Thessalonians 2:1)!

Needless to say, Lucifer is ready to confound and confuse the believer at every turn. I once heard a story about a demonic conference wherein the devil asked his minions how they might keep people away from the Gospel. One offered, "Tell them that the Bible has too many rules which impact mortal desires." The devil thought about it for a moment and replied, "Sounds good, but that doesn't work very well because there are many hopeful things in the Bible and mortals also like hopeful things." Another suggested, "Tell them the Bible is full of errors so they won't know what to believe." The devil responded, "That too is good thinking, but unfortunately the Bible has more evidences of its authenticity than Caesar's Gallic Wars so that won't work either." After a moment of silence, another offered this: "Tell them that the Godhead exists, and that the Bible is

true, but that they have plenty of time to decide on salvation." "Bingo!" replied the devil. "That's it. When we tell them that, they will resist the Gospel thinking they are going to live a long time and that they can decide later. Just think of the numbers we can lead astray into hell! Let it be done."

So then let us rejoice as we watch for our Lord's coming and observe the signs of the times as he has commanded. We have God's prophecies in the Old Testament and we have the promises of Christ in the New Testament. And we should be actively laboring in the harvest and standing fast in our spiritual warfare against the forces of darkness so that when our Lord comes for us, we will be in accord with his will when he said, *Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find [him] so doing* (St. Matthew 24: 46). May you likewise mark and remember.

Let us pray,

FATHER, grant to us the wisdom to follow those things that you have set forth within the pages of Scripture; that in so doing, our lives will be fruitful, so that at the last, we might be welcomed home as good stewards, faithful witnesses and stalwart soldiers in thy service; all these things we ask in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. *Amen*.
