#### Sunday Report



Sunday was the Fourth Sunday in Advent, the period including the four Sundays before Christmas; the first Sunday of which is always the nearest Sunday to the feast of St. Andrew (30 November). Advent is a season of preparation and penitence. We prepare ourselves to celebrate the coming of Jesus at Christmas, but we also look forward to his second coming. The liturgical color for this season is purple reminding us of the Kingship of Jesus and that Advent is also a season of penitential preparation.

#### *Propers*

Each Sunday there are Propers: special prayers and readings from the Bible. There is a Collect for the Day; that is a single thought prayer, most written either before the re-founding of the Church of England in the 1540s or written by Bishop Thomas Cranmer, the first Archbishop of Canterbury after the re-founding.

The Collect for the Day is to be read on Sunday and during Morning and Evening Prayer until the next Sunday. The Epistle is normally a reading from one of the various Epistles,

or letters, in the New Testament. The Gospel is a reading from one of the Holy Gospels, Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. The Collect is said by the minister as a prayer, the Epistle can be read by either a designated reader (as we do in our church) or by one of the ministers and the Holy Gospel, which during the service in our church is read by an ordained minister.

The propers are the same each year, except if a Red Letter Feast, that is one with propers in the prayerbook, falls on a Sunday, then those propers are to be read instead, except in a White Season, where it is put off. Red Letter Feasts, so called because in the Altar Prayerbooks the titles are in red, are special days. Most of the Red Letter Feasts are dedicated to early saints instrumental in the development of the church, others to special events. Some days are particularly special and the Collect for that day is to be used for an octave (eight days) or an entire season, like Advent or Lent.

The Propers are found on Page 95-96, with the Collect first:

The Epistle for today came from Paul's first letter to the Philippians, starting at the Fourth Verse of the Fourth Chapter.

Paul calls on us to "Rejoice in the Lord always: and again I say, Rejoice." We are to lead the world to Christ by example, to "Let (y)our moderation be known unto all men." In this Advent season, as always, "The Lord is at hand." We are to worry about nothing, "but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God." Be joyful in all things, not for all things. And in the words we find at the end of the Holy Communion Service, may "the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus." Or to quote another, "Trust in God and Dread Naught."

**R**EJOICE in the Lord always: and again I say, Rejoice. Let your moderation be known unto all men. The Lord is at hand. Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Today's Holy Gospel came from the Gospel according to Saint John, the First Chapter,

beginning at the Nineteenth Verse. When they heard rumor of John the Baptist, Jews wondering if this might be the Messiah, sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, "Who art thou?" John told them, "I am not the Christ." Then, they cast about for who he might be, "Art thou Elias?"

Confounded, they asked, "Who art thou? that we may give an answer to them that sent us. What sayest thou of thyself?" He said, "I am the voice of one crying in the wilderness, Make straight the way of the Lord, as said the prophet Esaias." The Pharisees people were somewhat confused and asked, "Why baptizest thou then, if thou be not that Christ, nor Elias, neither that prophet?" John answered them, saying, I baptize with water: but there standeth one among you, whom ye know not; he it is, who coming after me is preferred before me, whose shoe's latchet I am not worthy to unloose."

Interestingly, the same theme is found over and over, as is oft the case with truth. There are those among us who just plain will not see. For, there are none so deaf as those who will not hear and none so blind as those who will not see.

**T**HIS is the record of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, Who art thou? And he confessed, and denied not; but confessed, I am not the Christ. And they asked him, What then? Art thou Elias? And he saith, I am not. Art thou that prophet? And he answered, No. Then said they unto him, Who art thou? that we may give an answer to them that sent us. What sayest thou of thyself? These things were done in Bethabara beyond Jordan, where John was baptizing.

As is oft the case, today's propers all tie together to reinforce a point and build our understanding of what God wants and expects from each of us. The Collect asks for God's help for us to accept His Help and do it His Way. Because our sins do in fact hinder us from running the race that is set before us, that is to make it through the trials of this world and life and onto eternal life with our Lord. That is a thought that is constantly resonating throughout the Collects and not only them but all of Scriptures. That is because it is a constant truth that without the help of the Lord, we are but doomed to fail to follow Him. It is oft supposed Christians are dour souls, with no sense of happiness or humor. Perhaps this thought comes from those who have heard what the Bible says, but have never actually read it and understood it. For if they understood it then they would not think that we are dour at all! Reading the Bible as a whole proves this often popular train of thought to be patently false. That may have been the way the Puritans thought, but then again, the Puritans were not holding to the consistent truth of the Bible. After all God commands us to make a "joyful" noise unto the Lord! Not, a dour, grumbling and solemn noise, but an exceedingly JOYFUL noise unto the Lord! There is nothing in the Bible that says you cannot have fun whilst worshipping our Lord; in fact that is the preferred way to worship Him! If we enjoy worshipping the Lord, then we are most apt to do more of our best to follow Him, if we are enjoying ourselves whilst doing so!

After all, the one said to be the most dour of all, Paul, tells us to be happy. In his Epistle he mentioned rejoicing in the Lord always. Not just happy, but to REJOICE. REJOICE in the Lord ALWAYS and AGAIN I say REJOICE! How much more fun can you have? At the same time though Paul cautions us to be moderate in everything we do, no excesses, an even keel. Work hard, but maintain a time and space for our family, honor our country, and above all honor God. Maintain an even balance between work and play so to speak and moderation in both areas. However, that is nowhere near being dour; just being happy, but a cautious people. After all, if we eat too much, we end up paying the price for the gluttony. So too do we pay both spiritually and physically for exceeding moderation in all things. Paul is not trying to stop us from having Fun, he is trying to help us to have fun safely and in an enjoyable manner, where we can be able to use our full faculties as God intended. He goes on to tell us if we think we need something, simply ask God for it! Speaking of God, John recounts John the Baptist's role in preparing the way for Jesus. The Pharisees trouble with the simplicity of his message. They were looking for something more complex, less straightforward, something more like themselves. We have heard this often about the Pharisees; what they are looking for is something that people tend to look for instead of following God's message. For it is easier to get around this sort of message than God's very simple and straight forward one.

They were not willing to accept the change in the status quo; the New Testament would break their role in finding ways around the commandments Jesus gave. There is no way around the two commandments, namely of loving God with all our heart, soul and mind, and loving our neighbors as ourselves! Without those, we are just pitiful, weak, sinful beings! But, if we embrace those commandments, we start to shed our old man image, and put on a newer, shinier and better image. We then become, Man 2.0, quite the upgrade from the first version! We can then bring change to our lives and those changes in our lives will ripple out like a rock hitting the pond water and affect the lives of those

around us. We will never know the full extend of the impact, but if we keep living the Summary of the Law, our lives will be greatly enriched.

The Pharisees were a case of no play, all work and led a rather unbalanced life. The opposite of what Saint Paul suggests we do. They neither held to rejoicing in the Lord always, nor did they hold to moderation in all things. We are told to balance ourselves with play besides work, to make us into a happier people who will rejoice in God's commandments and will do His Work without complaint. We will be happier in the end if we do it His Way instead of our way as we are so wont to do, which is in our nature. The whole of Scriptures is about us fighting against our nature so we will be closer to what God intended us to be; a happy and holy people, living together in harmony. This goes back to what the collect says, we ask He would come into our hearts and help us to work towards that harmony, to help us run the great race set before us.

If the world would do what God asked, our lives would be so much better, we would all be living together in happiness. Peace on earth will not be possible until the world accepts Him into their hearts. This is the perfect season for those who haven't yet, to accept Him, to acknowledge Him at His first true appearance amongst us, at His Birth. Up until the end of our time here on earth, there is always time to accept Him, but do not wait until it is too late to do so! People can accept Him any at any time, but sooner rather than later is preferable. It is better to accept Him right away rather than wait until it is too late. That is why we much keep spreading and preaching the Gospel to all peoples and nations to fulfill the Great Commission.

Jesus also tells us to put our trust in the Lord, then not to worry. He knows how counterproductive, indeed, how destructive worry can be in our lives. We know it not only cannot, but will not do good, we know it will only hurt our cause; yet we do it. Is this not a proof positive of how much we need His Help? How hard is it to Trust in God and Dread Naught? Very! Extremely difficult as a matter of fact. Worry can be a really powerful negative emotion. We need to fight this emotion as nothing good comes from excessive worrying. The best cure to worry is to pray for God for guidance and to act upon that guidance. Even though it is very hard to trust somebody you can't see physically, you must trust your spiritual sense and follow Him anyway! Knowing you will see Him physically one day is one of our great rewards. This greatly eases at least my worries and should ease yours as well. There is always going to be a great evil in this day and age and we do not need to add to our existing problems by worrying. Worry solves nothing and simply creates more problems for you. It is an activity we need to do our best to stop doing.

When Saint John is recording the actions of John the Baptist, he tells us that when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, *Who art thou?* They got an answer they neither expected nor really understood, he said, *I am the voice of one crying in the wilderness, Make straight the way of the Lord, as said the prophet Esaias ... I baptize with water: but there standeth one among you, whom ye know not; he it is, who coming after me is preferred before me, whose shoe's latchet I am not worthy to unloose.* They had no clue what he was talking about. All they could see was what they expected, a king of this world. Yet, John the Baptist knew the kingdom was not of this world, for the King was no of this World, but the Eternal King of Eternity. John the Baptist later says *He must increase, but I must decrease.* (John 3:30) This is true of us, also. We must let Jesus permeate us and become the dominant force in us. But, it does not happen in the *twinkling of the eye*. Jack Lewis tells us, *We are doing well enough if the slow process of being more in Christ and less in ourselves has made a decent beginning in a long life (it will be completed only in the next world).* Jack Lewis

suggest you try his plan; I pray 'Lord, show me just so much (neither more nor less) about myself as I need for doing thy will now.'

The world is extremely complex; it is full of problems, temptations and difficulties. It is full of obstacles for us, yet all Christianity offers is a few simple solutions. We often hear there are no simple answers to complex questions. Actually, that is not true. There are simple answers to complex problems, they are the only ones which can and will work. The problem is they are not the answers people want. Most people do not want to know what they are supposed to do, lest they have to do it. They want to be told what they want to do is at least okay, even though it is clearly not okay. But we need to know what we are doing is actually "Okay", not what Joe on the corner claims is Okay. To do that, we have to read the Scriptures and listen to what God says is Okay, because He really does know the best in this matter for us.

Once again, when you think about being a Christian, think a bit about these quotes from GK Chesterton:

- Christianity has not been tried and found wanting; it has been found difficult and not tried.
- The word *good* has many meanings. For example, if a man were to shoot his grandmother at a range of five hundred yards, I should call him a good shot, but not necessarily a good man.
- The Bible tells us to love our neighbors, and also to love our enemies; probably because generally they are the same people.
- Tolerance is the virtue of the man without convictions.
- A dead thing can go with the stream, but only a living thing can go against it.

We are called to a new and different life, we ask the Lord to both lead us and follow us, to keep us always. Our goal is to *do* the Lord's will, not to *avoid* 613 laws. To do what is right and be humble.

For almost 200 years skeptics have tried to separate the Old Testament from the New Testament. If you can show that there is little to any relationship between the two testaments then you can call into question the whole concept of foreshadowing, prophecy, and fulfillment of said prophecy. The skeptics have to have a strong faith to NOT believe that the two testaments are connected. They really must ignore so many related verses pertaining to the first Advent of the Messiah and the second Advent. For again and again we see written prophecy fulfilled time and again during the season of reflection, anticipation, revelation and the Word made flesh to dwell among us;

Immanuel.

At the Advent season we can see so many connections as in our scripture passages for the Fourth Sunday in Advent. The connection between the verses in Isaiah and Luke; where he makes reference to Isaiah (Esaias), we see the ministry of John the baptizer who proceeds the coming Messiah, with both a message of repentance and of salvation.

John makes it very the behavior that is expected of those who have repented and turned from their evil ways. In the list of things they are to do, John points out the need to do righteous things. Notice the parallels concepts that will also be taught by Jesus. "...don't take advantage of your position or authority..., only do what you are supposed to do, be kind, share, help the helpless..." All of these ideas are bound up in the Golden Rule.

Now we see John explaining who he is. He baptizes with water, he who comes after him, he will baptize with the Holy Ghost and fire. John very humbly points to the ONE who will take away the sins of the world. The ONE who will bring comfort to his own, he will feed his sheep, he will gently lead those who are helpless. When Christ left the earth after his resurrection he indeed provided a comforter {the Holy Spirit}, he left shepherds {the disciples}, and he left his sheep {believers in him}. Look at what Isaiah writes in Verses 9 and 10....

**O** ZION, that bringest good tidings, get thee up into the high mountain; O Jerusalem, that bringest good tidings, lift up thy voice with strength; lift it up, be not afraid; say unto the cities of Judah, Behold your God! <sup>10</sup> Behold, the Lord God will come with strong hand, and his arm shall rule for him: behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him.

We see that work before him as the beginning of the church, the Word made flesh, shared with the rest of the world . Notice the contrast the prophet makes between man and God.

*...All flesh is grass, and all the goodness thereof is as the flower of the field: <sup>7</sup> The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: because the spirit of the Lord bloweth upon it: surely the people is grass. <sup>8</sup> The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the word of our God shall stand for ever...*

The Word of God shall stand for ever. That promise is fulfilled in the coming Savior.

Let us spend the next couple of hours reflecting upon the events that happened so many years ago in that dusty little town called Bethlehem. That little town, where the Word was made flesh, where God met man face to face, without man being in danger of instant death because God cannot look upon evil. Here God, by allowing his Son to become a little baby, entered into a three decade mission to reach mankind on his dimension, where God would provide the only means of salvation to his creations. God with us; Immanuel. And the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together: for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it.

Folks, we have no excuse. God has made his salvation visible to us, the first century people saw Jesus face to face. We see Jesus in the word of God that has been preserved for us, the Holy Bible is the message, Christ Jesus is the messenger, he is the reason for this season and why we should celebrate his coming; and most especially why we should share this message with our families, friends and strangers around us.

Let us celebrate His coming. Jesus Christ the Son of God came once as a helpless child, will come again in a triumphal procession. His glory shall be revealed and all flesh shall see it together: for the mouth of the Lord has spoken it.

God bless you all this holy season. May the Peace that passes all understanding be with you now and forever. *Amen.*

**L**ORD as we approach the commemoration of your first coming, the Nativity or birthday of Christ, let us be aware of those who would have us to remove Christ from every day life, to remove the saving knowledge from our society. ### **Fourth Sunday in Advent**

In Matthew 1:23, we were given the account of the birth and naming of our Lord wherein the apostle cited the words of the prophet Isaiah: Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel (7:14b). The name Emmanuel, or Immanuel, means *God with us* and is instructive as it made plain the intention of God to enter our world and to dwell among men so that he might bring them his redeeming grace. But to accomplish that redemption, he first had to clothe himself as a man in the flesh. He came in this manner to serve as a sacrifice so that those who would believe on him might have eternal life in his coming kingdom.

Surprisingly, quite a number of folks today will miss the truth recited by Isaiah and repeated by Matthew. While many of them may know the story of Jesus, they do not accept him as the only begotten Son of God. Some will claim that he was but a man and

nothing more. All those stories of his divinity are but figments of an over-active imagination. Others may accept him as an idealistic teacher, but one who is nonetheless dead and not coming back.

And so, because they believe as they do, Christmas is just another day off from work, or a holiday dedicated to some mythical personality, and not the ever living Son of God. They will then miss the essence of Christ which is after all the real reason for this season. Oh, they'll exchange presents and may even sing a Christmas carol or two. Perhaps they will attend church with family, and begrudgingly listen to a sermon concerning the Christ-child. But it will all be to no effect. They will come away as unconvinced as ever, particularly if they happen to attend some roadshowesque auditorium worship service where reverence for God has been set aside for entertainment and the cult of personality. They may even attend a church that has become so ritualized and emptied of the Holy Spirit that the best the minister can do is read from a child's story book concerning Christmas rather than read from the Scriptures and exposit to the congregation about the necessity for our Lord ever coming in the first place. So what are these folk really missing? They are missing heaven! And all who die without Christ will suffer an eternity without Christ.

But such does not have to be their fate. Our Lord has called upon all true and faithful Christians to be ambassadors and witnesses on his behalf. We are to proclaim the gospel message and make disciples wherever and whenever we can per the permission of the Holy Ghost. We are to have an answer for the faith which is within us should we be questioned by those of the unregenerated. God sent his Son into the world, that the world through him might be saved. Not the world system, but the inhabitants thereof (St. John 3:16-21). We should avoid the trap of attempting to save the world which the scriptures clearly speak against.

Rev EM Bounds noted in his work, Guide To Spiritual Warfare, "the purpose of the church of God is... to regenerate and sanctify the individual, to prepare him by purifying and training him for the high pursuits of eternal life. The church is like a net cast into the sea... [whose] purpose is not to change the sea but to catch fish out of the sea. Let the sea roll on its essential nature while the net catches its fishes... To attempt to save the world while ignoring the individual is not only Utopian but also destructive... To save the world sounds... commendable... but it will result in making the church worldly and unfit for her holy and sublime mission. Christ said that gaining the world and saving the man are opposing objectives (see Matthew 16:26)."

Clearly, we who have been regenerated by the Holy Spirit are called to be witnesses not alchemists. We cannot change the world system dominated by Satan any more than Medieval alchemists could change lead into gold. So then let us keep to those things that we can do, and leave the rest to the Master's capable hands.

Christmas is indeed a time of giving, but we need to understand the truth behind the season. Our gracious and loving God has given us a gift of inestimable value which he expects us to accept and then use throughout our lives. St. Paul taught that, *Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) and hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: that in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is a gift of God: not of works, lest any man should boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them* (Ephesians 2:5-10).

We who are born again of the Spirit have been saved with a mighty salvation. God the Father, because of his love for us, sent his only begotten Son to be sin for us. Without his first coming as that babe in Bethlehem— who grew to manhood, who faced the same temptations we have faced and did not give in, and who died for us on Calvary's cross— we would still be in our sins and trespasses with no hope of ever being freed from this body of sin and death. Only by means of his coming in the flesh, born of a pure virgin, would the promise of our redemption be made manifest. As we continue on through this season of Christmas, let us remember and give thanks to God for his gift to us and remember that Jesus Christ is truly God with us.

Let us pray,

**F**ATHER, we thank you for your gift to us of the Christ-child to become our Saviour; and we further ask for a wise and understanding heart so that we might better witness of him to those who are as yet in the grip of the evil one, that they might eventually turn unto him and be saved; all of which we ask in the name of him whom the Scriptures call Emmanuel, even Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*
